<u>Video overview</u>: Have you ever asked yourself why God doesn't just perform miracles all the time to reveal his presence so that everyone will believe in him? It's a valid question, but one of those questions that we might ignore or push to the back of our mind because we don't think there's a good answer. But these questions have answers in Catholic theology, and we are called to pray about these questions, because God will illuminate the answers to them. The readings today invite us into this mystery of our faith – why not miracles? Of course, there are *extraordinary* miracles of physical healing, for example, that do happen, but God does not *ordinarily* reveal himself to us in this way. Ordinarily, God moves in more gradual ways that invite us into deep friendship with him. We tend to ask for miracles that provide for our physical, worldly needs, but God is also concerned for our spiritual well-being and our final end of eternal life. Therefore, our spiritual well- being may not entail physical healing. In the Gospel today, Jesus chides the Israelites for seeking only earthly fulfillment. He calls them, and likewise us, to open our hearts to our deeper desire for God. Ultimately, God wants to fill our deepest longings for his infinite love.

<u>Featured study</u>: A story that is not finished yet. The Lady of Guadalupe video.

<u>Topic of Interest</u>: We are not the first people to seek after miracles from God. In today's readings, we see both the Israelites and the crowds surrounding Jesus acting like we do when we want God to prove his existence or to give us what we want. It is almost like we are treating God like a vending machine - I go to God, I give him what he wants, and then I get exactly what I want out of him. The pagans of ancient Greece and Rome treated their "gods" in a very similar way.



Protocol for Indoor Masses



Dear Brothers:

With the current surge of COVID-19 cases, pastors in Sacramento and Yolo Counties should instruct staff and parishioners to wear face coverings when indoors. This includes offices, churches, classrooms, and other public settings.

All pastors in the Diocese of Sacramento should continue to recommend that the Faithful wear masks indoors. Wearing masks and following other practical public health protocols is an act of charity and respect for one another. The pandemic still threatens the most vulnerable among us. For parishes, offices and schools in Sacramento and Yolo counties, please update your parish safety plans. The Office of Lay Personnel will provide updated signage as well as specific language to be employed in implementing these protocols.

All Pastors and the faithful should continue to observe sensible public health precautions:

- Practice frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer.
- Refrain from hand shaking and other forms of physical contact with others outside of one's household.
- Continue to clean the pews at least twice on Sundays and other days when there are multiple services.
- During the distribution of communion priests, deacons, and extraordinary ministers should wear facemasks and have sanitizer available for use when needed.

May the intercession of our Blessed Mother Mary and St. Joseph, her most chaste spouse, bring an end to the pandemic and fill us with the mercy and patience of the Lord Jesus.
