**Video overview:** Have you ever felt like you are competent in one particular activity? Maybe a sport, a task at your work, or getting the laundry folded regularly! You have finally mastered the particular task. And then, when you thought everything was (finally) going as you planned, something goes wrong. You get hurt, your work changes, a child gets sick, and everything is thrown off once again. Today, we will encounter this in a man who has been seeking to follow the commandments since he was a young boy. He thinks he has prepared himself well to enter into eternal life. But, when Jesus invites him to something deeper, something more, he is crushed, as he will have to “start over” in some ways. Are you willing to take the next step to growing closer to Jesus?

**Featured study:** Love-Sacrifice-Trust: He showed us the Way by Fr. Mike Schmitz

**Topic of Interest:** We often say we that “love” things. This word is thrown around quite a bit today - “I love Sunday donuts,” “I love that app”, “I love you, son.” There are different ways of speaking about love. Jesus asks us to love him today above all else. He asks us to put aside our personal habits and way of life, and even perhaps our bodily life, for him. Are you willing to follow him and love him in this radical way? Jesus makes an intimidating demand of us today. We must love him above all else. Because of our human weakness, this is much easier said than done. We often say that we love Jesus and that he is first in our lives, but whom or what do we turn to when we have a spare moment? Do we turn on the TV or spend a few minutes with Jesus? In the car, do we fill the time with the radio, or do we take time to pray part of the Rosary? How much time do we spend visiting him in the Blessed Sacrament, and how much time do we spend on fun activities or working out? How much do I really love Jesus?



## From the Pastor

### **Protocol for Indoor Masses** **Effective July 31, 2021**

- Face coverings shall be worn, regardless of vaccination status, over the mouth and nose, in all indoor public settings, venues, gatherings and workplaces. Hand sanitizer is available.
- If you wish to receive communion on the tongue, we highly recommend receiving it at the very end so as not to delay the distribution of Holy Communion. - The distribution of the cup is still suspended until further notice.
- All the Catholic Faithful in the Diocese of Sacramento are obliged to personally attend and actively participate in the Sunday celebration of the Sacrifice of the Mass (Canon 1247).
- Individuals who are sick or have a vulnerable health condition or are caring for someone with a vulnerable health condition are not obligated to attend the Eucharist on Sunday or other obligatory solemnities.
- All the faithful are encouraged to receive the COVID-19 vaccination when available. Please consult your doctor regarding any personal health concerns.

8. Announce the second mystery; then say the Our Father and repeat these steps as you continue through the remaining mysteries.
9. Say the Hail, Holy Queen
10. Make the Sign of the Cross

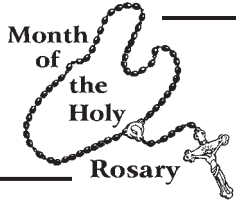

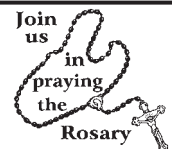
