### June 19, 2022, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body – Formed.org.

**Video overview:** Our reading focuses on one of Christ's most famous miracles—the miracle of multiplying bread and fish to feed five thousand men and as many as fifteen thousand to twenty thousand people in total with just five loaves and two fish. The miracle of the multiplication of loaves and fish is found in all four Gospels, signifying that it was considered one of the most meaningful miracles for all the Gospel writers. The miracle occurs when the apostles are asked to bring the small amount of the bread and fish they have to Christ and trust that he can satisfy the hunger of the large crowd of people. More than just keeping the crowd's hunger at bay, Christ superabundantly satisfied them as twelve baskets of food were left over. This miracle also serves as a sign pointing towards Jesus' institution of the Holy Eucharist. His Body and Blood are present after the words of consecration spoken by the priest. In the Eucharist, Jesus is truly present under the appearance of bread and wine. This wonderful truth is honored today by the Church with the feast of Corpus Christi, which is Latin for "Body of Christ."

**Featured study:** The Holy Eucharist with Bishop Barron

**Reflection:** In Luke's Gospel there are two instances of Jesus blessing, breaking, and giving bread: this miraculous feeding of the five thousand in Luke 9, and the story of Jesus' post-Resurrection appearance to two disciples on the road to Emmaus in Lk 24. The first is a prophecy of, and the second harkens back to, the gift of himself in bread at the Last Supper in Luke 22. In that passage, Jesus breaks and gives bread, but only after he "gave thanks." "Giving thanks" (eucharistein) is, of course, the root of our word "Eucharist." Just after this miraculous feeding of the five thousand, Jesus begins to tell his disciples about his coming Passion, that he must be "delivered into the hands of men" (9:44, RSV) and "suffer many things" (9:22, RSV). Then, near the end of chapter 9, Luke tells us that Jesus' "face was set toward Jerusalem" (9:53, RSV). In Luke 24, after Jesus was made known to the two disciples "in the breaking of the bread" (24:35), Luke tells us that these two, who had been walking away from Jerusalem in despair after Jesus' death, now "rose that same hour and returned to Jerusalem" (24:33, RSV). In Luke's two-part work, Luke - Acts, Jerusalem is the center of the action, the place Jesus goes to gain our salvation and then the place from which the apostles launch the proclamation of the Gospel of that salvation in Acts. Jerusalem is the center also because it represents for Luke the place of Eucharist, where Jesus, "when he had given thanks" (22:19, RSV), allows himself to be broken and given over into our hands for the life of the world.

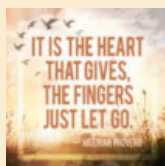

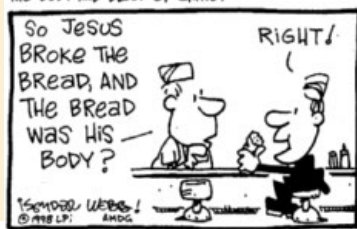

## POPE FRANCIS: PORNOGRAPHY IS 'A THREAT TO PUBLIC HEALTH'

Pope Francis on Friday spoke about the challenges facing families, including threats to human dignity such as pornography and surrogacy.

"We also talk about the scourge of pornography, which has now spread everywhere via the web," the pope said at the Vatican on June 10.

"It should be denounced as a permanent attack on the dignity of men and women. It is not only a matter of protecting children – an urgent task of the authorities and all of us – but also of declaring pornography a threat to public health," he told members of a family association network.

Quoting a 2017 speech he gave to a congress on child dignity online, the pope added that "it would be a serious illusion to think that a society in which abnormal consumption of sex on the web is rampant among adults is then capable of effectively protecting minors."

Family networks, schools, and local communities are crucial to combat pornography and to help heal the wounds of those addicted, he said.

"The dignity of men and women is also threatened," he continued, "by the inhumane and increasingly widespread practice of 'womb renting,' in which women, almost always poor, are exploited, and children are treated as commodities."

## CALIFORNIA BISHOPS OPPOSE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PROMOTE ABORTION

### SCA 10 looks to enshrine the most extreme forms of abortion into the California Constitution.

Bishop Jaime Soto shares the following comment on Senate Constitutional Amendment 10:

"Join my brother bishops and me in opposing Senate Constitutional Amendment (SCA) 10. This measure would put an initiative on the November ballot amending the California State Constitution to include broad abortion rights.

"The state's political leadership continues to stubbornly cling to the practice of abortion and the throw-away culture. It is reprehensible to enshrine in the State Constitution the practice of abortion even until moments before delivery. The language of SCA 10 is overly vague, reckless and could further endanger children, especially among the poor and marginalized in our state.
