Video overview: Jesus teaching his disciples...and by extension all of us...how to pray to God as “Our Father.” Through those words that most us know by heart, we acknowledge our relationship as one of a beloved child coming to ask a loving parent for the things we need. But immediately after the “Our Father,” Jesus tells the parable of the man who asks his neighbor for bread in the middle of the night, a story that contains the famous line: “For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened” (Luke 11:10). At first, the two don’t seem like they go together, but Jesus is giving us another important truth: God is our Father, but God is also our friend. This dual relationship—Father and friend—is important for us to understand for our prayer life. At the center of this mystery is the reality that God desires to be “in relationship” with us, connecting with us heart to heart. And as we are drawn deeper and deeper into that relationship, we will experience an ever-increasing friendship with God and a growing confidence in approaching him with our needs and the needs of others. In short, we will learn to be with God both as Father and friend.

Featured study: God comes to meet us.

Reflection: St. Luke gives a shorter version of the Our Father and then a commentary on prayer. This variant form of the Our Father suggests that the prayer we so often say, based on the longer version in Matthew’s Gospel, was probably intended more as a skeletal framework for prayer than as a rote prayer to be repeated again and again. Not that there is anything wrong with doing so, of course, because when we repeat the Our Father with proper attention and concentration, its form sinks into our hearts and informs our other spontaneous prayers, as well. Jesus’ disciples ask him to teach them how to pray, something that would have been common for the disciples of a rabbi of Jesus’ day. But Jesus’ prayer is unusual in that it addresses God as “Father.” This is what the Catechism of the Catholic Church calls the newness of “filial prayer” in Christ “But his prayer springs from an otherwise secret source, as he intimates at the age of twelve: “I must be in my Father’s house.” Here the newness of prayer in the fullness of time begins to be revealed: his filial prayer, which the Father awaits from his children, is finally going to be lived out by the only Son in his humanity, with and for men.” (CCC 2599). As the eternal Son of the Father, Jesus alone can rightly call God his father. But he freely chooses to admit us to a share of his perfect Sonship, making us sons and daughters of the Father in him. And that theme informs what follows, too, in the commentary when Jesus first asks, “What father among you...” and then answers, “How much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him.” He explains that the Father’s love is certain to respond to his beloved children, so long as we insistently “ask,” “seek,” and “knock” in prayer.

4. To form, inspire, and launch missionary disciples, filled with love of God and neighbor that comes from an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist, to the margins of the Church and the world.

WHO WILL BE INVOLVED?

The goal of the National Eucharistic Revival is to engage every Catholic in the United States! This is a movement, not a program, and is meant to provide opportunities for the faithful to fall deeper in love with Jesus in the Eucharist and to be inspired and equipped to share that love with others.

The efforts of the Revival are being organized by a team of lay men and women, religious, priests, and bishops from across the United States. An advisory board of bishops is shepherding the whole Revival.

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am.

Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

POPE FRANCIS CONSIDERS IT AN 'INCOHERENCE' THAT PRESIDENT BIDEN, A CATHOLIC, SUPPORTS ABORTION RIGHTS

Pope Francis has described it as an "incoherence" that President Joe Biden, a Catholic, is in favor of legal abortion.

During an interview with Univisión and Televisa broadcast July 12, Pope Francis spoke about abortion and Biden's position, after being asked about whether to admit politicians who promote legal abortion to Holy Communion.

The Holy Father affirmed that there is scientific data that show that "a month after conception, the DNA of the fetus is already there and the organs are aligned. There is human life."

"Is it just to eliminate a human life?" he then asked.

As for the defense of abortion by the U.S. president, Pope Francis stated that he leaves it to Biden's "conscience."

"Let (Biden) talk to his pastor about that incoherence," the pope said.

Though a Catholic, Biden has repeatedly supported abortion rights despite the Church's teaching that human life must be respected and protected from the moment of conception.

Last week Biden signed an executive order aimed at protecting abortion access in response to the Supreme Court's decision to overturn Roe v. Wade, which legalized abortion throughout the U.S.

In September 2021, Biden said he did not "agree" that life begins at conception. "I have been and continue to be a strong supporter of Roe v. Wade," he said at the White House, answering a reporter's question on abortion. "I respect them — those who believe life begins at the moment of conception and all — I respect that. Don't agree, but I respect that," he said.
