Video overview: Jesus says, “For where your treasure is, there also your heart will be.” Jesus is asking, “What are your priorities? What’s most important in your life?” Ask yourself, “How many hours of TV do I watch daily” Many people may say that they love God, but is that where their heart is, or is their heart filled and divided with many things that distract them from God and even take them away from God? Are our families where our treasure lies, or are we easily distracted by cell phones, the Internet, TV, hobbies, and so on? This Gospel reading provides us the opportunity to take stock of our priorities and to discern whether we treasure what is truly important and lasting in life—especially what lasts for eternity, the state of our soul and our relationship with God; almsgiving, to share our treasure, most specifically our financial treasures, with those who are in need. The blessings that God gives us are not to be kept for ourselves but are to be given to the poor and those in need. When we give alms, the book of Proverbs says it is like we are giving a loan to God, to use the blessings he has bestowed on us to help others [“He who has compassion on the poor lends to the LORD, and he will repay him for his good deed.” Proverbs 19:17]. The beautiful thing is that God promises to pay us back one hundredfold for our generosity and faith. The question that Jesus poses to us this week is whether we have the faith to give of our treasures and trust God in his love and generosity.

Featured study: Why Almsgiving?

Reflection: Jesus here instructs his disciples on the skills required for being a watchman, someone who is prepared for the Lord’s return. First, we are to live in the kingdom, not relying on earthly treasure but on that heavenly treasure that is won by almsgiving. We are also to be vigilant, awake, dressed, and attentive for his coming. The Catechism says that vigilance at prayer is “custody of the heart” (CCC 2849) and that “in prayer the disciple keeps watch, attentive to Him Who Is and Him Who Comes, in memory of his first coming in the lowliness of the flesh, and in the hope of his second coming in glory” (CCC 2612). The whole of Christian history, the history of the Church, is the story of the great night watch. At this point in our collective journey through time, “salvation is nearer to us now than when we first believed” and “the night is far gone, the day is at hand,” (Romans 13:11-12, RSV). We can’t be sure if we are “in the second or third watch” of that night, but the proper Christian stance in any age is that of watchfulness, of earnest Christian living in faith, hope, and love.

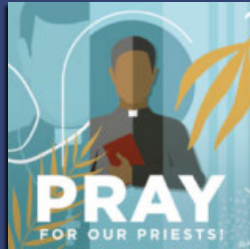

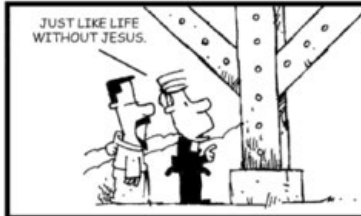

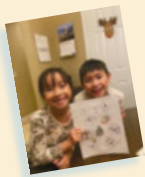

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am.

Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

COVETING WEALTH AND POSSESSIONS BLINDS US TO THE 'TRUE GOODS OF LIFE,' POPE FRANCIS SAYS

A day after returning to Rome from his weeklong trip to Canada, Pope Francis on Sunday reflected on the dangers of coveting wealth and possessions. In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus responds to a man who wants his brother to share his inheritance with him. "Take care to guard against all greed," Jesus tells the crowd, "for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions" (Lk. 12:15)

The Holy Father noted that rather than entering into the details of the man's situation, He "goes to the root of the divisions caused by the possession of things": covetousness.

"What is covetousness? It is the unbridled greed for possessions, always desiring to be rich," the pope said, speaking to pilgrims in St. Peter's Square before the weekly recitation of the Angelus.

"This is an illness that destroys people, because the hunger for possessions creates an addiction. Above all, those who have a lot are never content, they always want more, and only for themselves. But this way, the person is no longer free: he or she is attached to, a slave, of what paradoxically was meant to serve them so as to live freely and serenely," Pope Francis warned. "Rather than being served by money, the person becomes a servant of money."

The pope identified covetousness as a "dangerous illness for society as well," pointing to the greed that fuels wars and in particular the "scandal" of the arms trade.

"And so, let us try to ask ourselves: Where am I at with my detachment from possessions, from wealth?" the pope asked. "Do I complain about what I lack, or do I know how to be content with what I have? In the name of money or opportunity, am I tempted to sacrifice relationships and sacrifice time with others? And yet again, does it happen that I sacrifice legality and honesty on the altar of covetousness?"

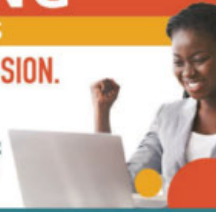

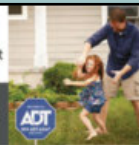
