Video overview:

Habakkuk, one of the twelve minor prophets of the Old Testament, lived at a time in Israel's history when Babylon had just become a threat to Judah. Here, Habakkuk poses the question that has always vexed mankind: Why do the innocent suffer evil? In the short portion we have of the reply of the Lord to Habakkuk's question, we don't find anything like an explanation, only an invitation to faith. "The just man, because of his faith, shall live," he's told. Many commentators draw a comparison between Habakkuk and the book of Job where the question of suffering receives the closest examination in the Old Testament. One similarity is that both Habakkuk and Job end finally with worship. Perhaps worship in faith is finally the only answer to human suffering.

Featured study: Lectio: Salvation: Episode 3: Not without Cost

Reflection: In speaking to his apostles in this week's Gospel reading, Jesus asks them to reflect again on the proper relationship between master and servant. It may seem odd that those who are closest to Jesus should be schooled like servants while those who are wary of Jesus should be taught as sons; but Luke is interested in all those who will follow Jesus without benefit of having been Jewish insiders. Having been servants of God outside of the covenant of Israel, they'll be transformed into children of God; the new Israel after Jesus' work of redemption is done. The good teacher doesn't require more of his students than they're able to give and so Jesus schools the servants of God to be good servants and doesn't demand that they act like children of the household until they've received their inheritance. That may well account for the phrase "If you have faith..." The disciples aren't even ready to exercise their faith.





Anointing of the Sick:

By appointment.

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primer Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Vatican holds contest to choose music for official hymn of 2025 Jubilee Year

The Vatican will hold a contest to choose the original musical composition for the official hymn of the Catholic Church's 2025 Jubilee Year.

The Dicastery for Evangelization announced the sacred music writing competition Sept. 17. The contest will open for submissions early next year.

Entries, the dicastery said, should set to music a text in Italian by the theologian Monsignor Pierangelo Sequeri. After the winning music is chosen next year, the evangelization office will translate the text into other major languages.

The text is titled "Pilgrims of Hope," after the theme of the 2025 Jubilee. The refrain, translated into English by CNA, is: "Living flame of my hope, / May this song reach up to Thee! Eternal womb of infinite life, / On my way I trust in Thee." According to the regulations set out by the Vatican, the musical composition should include a score for voice and organ, and be able to be sung both by church congregations and by four-part church choirs.

The competition will be open for submissions from Jan. 16 to March 25, 2023, and the winner will be chosen by a judging committee in collaboration with the Pontifical Institute of Sacred Music. Full regulations can be found on the webpage of the 2025 Jubilee.

A Jubilee is a special Holy Year of grace and pilgrimage in the Catholic Church. An ordinary Jubilee typically takes place every 25 years, though a pope may call for additional Jubilees, as Pope Francis did with the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy from 2015-2016.

"The motto, 'Pilgrims of Hope,'" it said, "is best echoed biblically in some pages from the prophet Isaiah (Isaiah 9 and Isaiah 60). The themes of creation, fraternity, God's tenderness and hope in our destination resonate in a language, which although not 'technically' theological, is in substance and in the allusions, so that it rings eloquently in the ears of our time."

The full lyrics of what will become the official hymn of the 2025 Jubilee can be found on CNA website. It has been translated into English from the Italian original by CNA.
