Review: The Catechism tells us that the Eucharist is the "source and summit" of the Christian life (CCC, 1324). All of the other sacraments point toward the reality of what the Eucharist really is: the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord. What a tremendous and humbling gift to receive the Creator into our hearts and souls. Today we will delve into the Scriptures surrounding this great mystery.

Featured study: Lectio: Eucharist with Dr. Brant Pitre. This study is a must for every Catholic, especially parents of adult children.

Reflection: In Mark's account of the Last Supper is interwoven with references to the Passover. The chapter opens with the leaders of the Jews in Jerusalem planning to put Jesus to death. The time is two days before Passover, when devout Jews were likely selecting the sacrificial lamb for the Passover meal. The feast of Unleavened Bread, which coincides with the feast of Passover, arrives. The account of the meal itself is brief, but telling. There is no mention of the Passover lamb, highlighting that Jesus himself is the sacrificial offering. And the meal is not concluded in the traditional way with a final cup of wine. Instead, a new covenant has been established with the Blood of the Christ (fulfilling the covenant we read about in the first reading). But the new Passover feast is not finished, for after giving the cup of his Blood, Jesus says he not going to drink anymore until he drinks anew in the Kingdom of God. Then they sing a hymn and set out to Garden of Gethsemane. The sacrificial celebration continues to Calvary, uniting both symbol and reality.

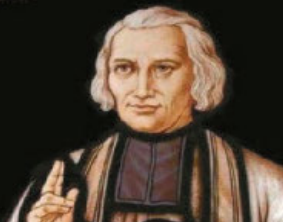
Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

On this the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, let us contemplate the gift that the true presence is to us.

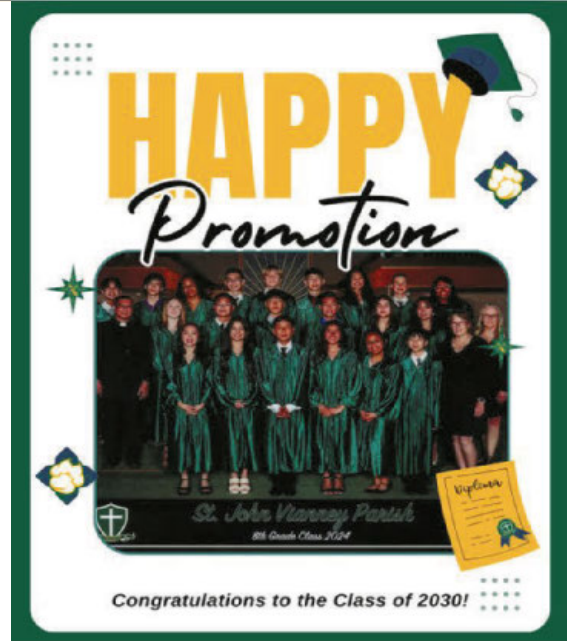

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held once a month on Sunday from 11:30am-2:30pm.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

WHAT IS THE CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD?

What is the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd? Who can enroll in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd? The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori approach to religious education for our youngest children. The catechesis has 3 levels, and each level is taught for 3 years. Saint John Vianney offers Level 1 to children ages 3 to 6 years old. Through the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS), children form a deep, lifelong relationship with Jesus, our Good Shepherd. OCIA Adult Faith Formation

We live in a cultural moment that's witnessing the sunset of secularism. Rising in the East a new cultural order is emerging. We, God's people, have the Good News — the euangélion — to inform and shape that new cultural order.

Pope on Pentecost: We are not alone, but helped and empowered by the Holy Spirit

Even at the most challenging of times or amid the day-to-day struggles, the Holy Spirit and His gifts enable us to persevere... Pope Francis gave this comforting reminder during his homily on the Solemnity of Pentecost on Sunday in the Vatican, marking the end of the Easter Season.

During the Eucharistic celebration in St. Peter's Basilica, the Pope drew his cue from the account of Pentecost in the Acts of the Apostles, which he observed, shows the Holy Spirit's operating in the Church, both in us and in mission, with the characteristics of power and gentleness.

The Pope remembered how the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples and remained at their side, as the Paraclete "who transformed their hearts and instilled in them a serene courage which impelled them to pass on to others their experience of Jesus and the hope which motivated them."

...We are to do so, he said, without "arrogance, impositions, or calculating," but with "the energy born of fidelity to the truth that the Spirit teaches us in our hearts and causes to grow within us." Consequently, Pope Francis suggested, "we do not give up, but tirelessly speak of peace to those who desire war, speak of forgiveness to those who seek revenge, speak of welcome and solidarity to those who bar their doors and erect barriers, speak of life to those who choose death, to speak of respect to those who love to humiliate, insult and reject, and to speak of fidelity to those who would sever every bond."

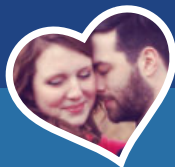

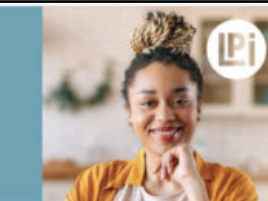
