Word of Life

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time: Defend Jesus and Remain with Him

“As a result of this, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him. Jesus then said to the Twelve, ‘Do you also want to leave?’ Simon Peter answered him, ‘Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God.’” (John 6: 66-69)

This Sunday, we meditate on the sorrowful question that Jesus asks His apostles when He saw that some who followed Him had left when He stopped being a “business” for them. He asks each one of us that same question every day. He also asks it of all those who, on some occasion, have approached Him for help out of need. Looking sadly into our eyes, He asks, “Do you also want to leave, as your friends have done and as most of those around you have done? Will you also leave Me when things get ugly and you have to take risks to be by My side? Will you also leave when you can no longer get anything from Me or when you don’t understand some of My plans?”

Faced with these questions, an easy or rhetorical answer is not enough. It is not enough to just move your mouth saying to Jesus, “Lord, even if everyone abandons You, I will not.” as Peter said the night of Holy Thursday, just before denying Him three times and hearing the rooster crow. Nor is it enough to try to satisfy Him by giving alms or by going to Mass on Sunday. We have to assure Him, with all the sincerity that our fragile hearts are capable of, that we want to be by His side, like true friends, through good times and bad. We have to assure Him not only with words and deeds but also with works that we are already doing and will continue doing, out of love for Him, even if we have no other reward than to bring Him a little joy.

Resolution: Betraying Jesus and leaving His side when others criticize and leave Him means you are denying Him. Do the opposite: come to His defense and stay.



From the Pastor

My dear parishioners,

We are finalizing the month of August dedicated to forming the conscience to participate in the political sphere with a “mind like Christ”. This time I would like to share the last two principles of the Church’s social teaching: Solidarity and Subsidiarity.

“Solidarity is “a firm and persevering determination to commit oneself to . . . The good of all and of each individual, because we are all really responsible for all.” We are one human family, whatever our national, racial, ethnic, economic, and ideological differences. The person is social in nature; we develop and flourish within a community. As baptized members of the community of the Church, we are part of one body in Christ and we are also part of one global human family.”

“Solidarity requires that in our prayer and in our political engagement, those who are weak, vulnerable, and most in need receive preferential concern.”

“The principle of Subsidiarity reminds us that larger institutions in society (such as the state or federal government) should not overwhelm or interfere with smaller or local institutions (such as the family, local schools, or the Church community). Yet larger institutions have essential responsibilities when local institutions cannot adequately protect human dignity, meet human needs, or advance the common good. Subsidiarity reflects the essential freedom and innate human dignity of each person while also recognizing the role higher authorities, such as government, can play to ensure that all people are able to thrive.”

“Family—based on marriage between a man and a woman— is the first and most fundamental unit of society: a sanctuary for the creation and nurturing of children. It should be defended and strengthened, not redefined, undermined, or further distorted.”

“It is important to uphold parents’ rights and responsibilities to care for their children, including the right to direct their children’s education in accordance with their convictions, with support rather than interference from the state.”

“... Parents should receive support through work, training, assistance with childcare, healthcare, housing and transportation....”

Palabras Del Pastor

Mis queridos feligreses,

Estamos finalizando el mes de agosto dedicado a formar la conciencia para participar en la esfera política con una «mente como la de Cristo». En esta ocasión me gustaría compartir los dos últimos principios de la doctrina social de la Iglesia: Solidaridad y Subsidiariedad.

“La solidaridad es “la determinación firme y perseverante de empeñarse por... el bien de todos y cada uno, para que todos seamos verdaderamente responsables de todos”. Somos una familia humana, independientemente de nuestras diferencias nacionales, raciales, étnicas, económicas e ideológicas. La persona es de naturaleza social; nos desarrollamos y prosperamos dentro de una comunidad. Como miembros bautizados de la comunidad de la Iglesia, somos parte de un solo cuerpo en Cristo y también somos parte de una familia humana global.”

“La solidaridad requiere que en nuestra oración y en nuestro compromiso político, aquellos que son débiles, vulnerables y más necesitados reciban una atención preferencial.”

“El principio de subsidiariedad nos recuerda que las instituciones más grandes de la sociedad (como el gobierno estatal o federal) no deben abrumar ni interferir con las instituciones que son más pequeñas o tienen carácter local (como la familia, las escuelas locales o la comunidad eclesial). Sin embargo, las instituciones más grandes tienen responsabilidades esenciales cuando las instituciones locales no pueden adecuadamente proteger la dignidad humana, responder a las necesidades humanas o promover el bien común. La subsidiariedad refleja la libertad esencial y la dignidad humana innata de cada persona, al mismo tiempo que reconoce el papel que pueden desempeñar las autoridades superiores, como el gobierno, para garantizar que todas las personas puedan prosperar.”

“La familia —basada en el matrimonio entre un hombre y una mujer— es la primera y fundamental unidad de la sociedad y es un santuario para la creación y crianza de los niños. Debería ser defendida y fortalecida, y no redefinida, socavada o distorsionada aún más”.

“Es importante defender los derechos y responsabilidades de los padres de cuidar a sus hijos, incluido el derecho a dirigir la educación de sus hijos de acuerdo con sus convicciones, con apoyo y no interferencia del Estado...”

“... Los padres deberían recibir apoyo a través del trabajo, la formación, la asistencia con el cuidado de los niños, el cuidado de salud, la vivienda y el transporte...”

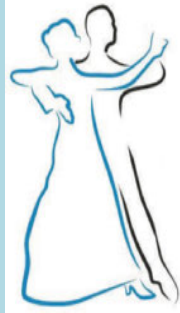

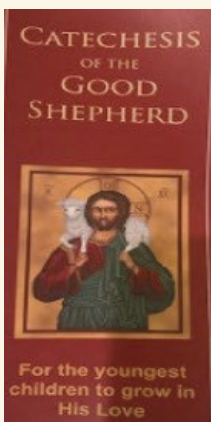

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held once a month on Sunday from 11:30am-2:30pm.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.

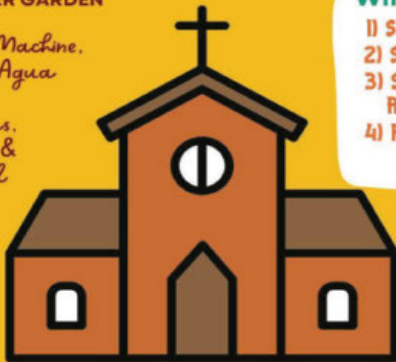

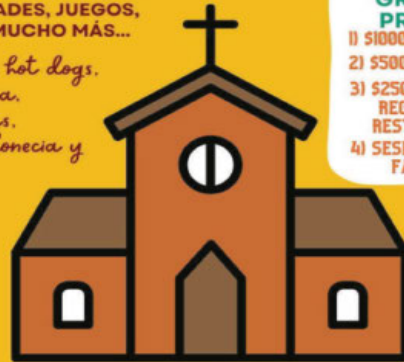
