Word of Life

27th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Take Care of Your Family

The Pharisees approached and asked, "Is it lawful for a husband to divorce his wife?" He said to them in reply... Therefore what God has joined together, no human being must separate." (Mark 10: 2, 9)

This week's Gospel deals with the always difficult and always current problem of divorce. The proof of its difficulty is that the Pharisees raised it with Jesus "to put him to the test." They knew of the Lord's mercy and sought to put him in a bind, having to decide between pleasing those who seek a solution to their marital failure through divorce and respecting divine law.

Jesus uses a sentence that leaves no room for doubt: "What God has joined, man must not separate." But He is not satisfied with that. Even before affirming that resounding defense of the marriage bond, He speaks of love, which manifests itself in the fact that the two, husband and wife, become one flesh. That is precisely what this week will be about: promoting everything that contributes to love, that favors love. Marital breakdowns do not happen as if by magic, but they brew little by little. Before the final breakup, there are a thousand small daily disagreements. It is as if a thick rope, formed by a thousand strands of thread, are unraveling until there is nothing left but a fine bond that is broken with one last blow. Then, it is about applying preventive medicine. It is about believing in marriage, both from a social and a sacramental point of view. And because one believes in the value of marriage for life and the value of the family, it is worth sacrificing for them. Not forgetting that while preserving the family has a price, a breakup and divorce have another, which is usually even more costly.

Resolution: Analyze what the situation is in the family itself and what can be done to improve it, as well as what must be avoided so that it does not deteriorate. Now that it's not too late, take care of your family.



From the Pastor |

Palabras Del Pastor

My dear parishioners,

As we prepare for November, which I have named "The Month of Gratitude," this introductory reflection on the charism of gratitude begins by considering it as a part of the virtue of justice applied to our relationship with God.

St. Thomas Aquinas points it out in his *Summa Theologiae* that gratitude is a human virtue. "Human virtues are firm attitudes, stable dispositions, habitual perfections of intellect and will that govern our actions, order our passions, and guide our conduct according to reason and faith. They make possible ease, self-mastery, and joy in leading a morally good life." (1) Virtues are so important because we are better and better interiorly perfected and disposed to know the truth, to love what is good and to accomplish excellent actions with more spontaneity, freedom and joy.

The virtue of gratitude is linked to a deep sense and awareness of duty, because it is a manifestation of the virtue of justice. "Justice is the moral virtue that consists in the constant and firm will to give their due to God and neighbor."

(2) The first person we must do justice to is God, and then to our neighbor. The virtue of religion is the application of the virtue of justice to God. The religious person acknowledges that absolutely everything is dependent on God, including their own existence. This acknowledgment is manifested through a series of rituals and symbols, which we call worship, and one of the expressions of worship that stems from the human heart is thanksgiving. When we give thanks to God, we acknowledge him as the benefactor of all goods, thus making ourselves His debtors.

The first thing I would like us to consider about the virtue of gratitude is that it is much more than courtesy. Normally, politeness stays on the outside; it does not necessarily touch the heart or bind the person to a sense of duty. On the contrary, gratitude to God binds our entire lives to the demands of His love and goodness. Thankfulness, therefore, implies a conscious dependence on God, the source of all that we have and are, and denounces a society in which a true sense of justice towards God is not practiced. Proof of this is that most people live as if unbound to God, as if He did not exist.

Mis queridos feligreses,

Mientras nos preparamos para el mes de noviembre, que he llamado «El mes del agradecimiento», esta reflexión introductoria sobre el carisma del agradecimiento comienza considerándola como una parte de la virtud de la justicia aplicada a nuestra relación con Dios.

Santo Tomás de Aquino señala en su Suma Teológica que el agradecimiento es una virtud humana. «Las virtudes humanas son actitudes firmes, disposiciones estables, perfecciones habituales del entendimiento y de la voluntad que regulan nuestros actos, ordenan nuestras pasiones y guían nuestra conducta según la razón y la fe. Proporcionan facilidad, dominio y gozo para llevar una vida moralmente buena» (1). Las virtudes son tan importantes porque nos perfeccionan y disponen interiormente cada vez mejor a conocer la verdad, a amar el bien y a realizar acciones excelentes con más espontaneidad, libertad y gozo.

La virtud del agradecimiento está ligada a un profundo sentido y conciencia del deber, porque es una manifestación de la virtud de la justicia. «La justicia es la virtud moral que consiste en la constante y firme voluntad de dar a Dios y al prójimo lo que les es debido». (2) La primera persona a la que debemos hacer justicia es Dios, y después a nuestro prójimo. La virtud de la religión es la aplicación de la virtud de la justicia a Dios. La persona religiosa reconoce que absolutamente todo depende de Dios, incluida su propia existencia. Este reconocimiento se manifiesta a través de una serie de rituales y símbolos, que llamamos culto, y una de las expresiones del culto que nace del corazón humano es la acción de gracias. Cuando damos gracias a Dios, le reconocemos como benefactor de todos los bienes, convirtiéndonos así en deudores suyos.

Lo primero que me gustaría que consideráramos sobre la virtud del agradecimiento es que es mucho más que cortesía. Generalmente, la cortesía se queda en el exterior; no llega necesariamente al corazón ni vincula a la persona a un sentido del deber. Por el contrario, el agradecimiento hacia Dios vincula toda nuestra vida a las exigencias de Su amor y bondad. El agradecimiento, por tanto, implica una dependencia consciente de Dios, fuente de todo lo que tenemos y somos, y denuncia a una sociedad en la que no se practica un verdadero sentido de justicia para con Dios. Prueba de ello, es que se vive como desvinculados de Dios, como si Él no existiera.
