Word of Life

3rd Sunday of Lent: Do Not Abuse the Goodness of the Lord

The vinedresser said to him in reply, "Sir, leave it for this year also, and I shall cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it; it may bear fruit in the future. If not, you can cut it down." (Lk 13: 8-9).

When we are young, it seems that time is infinite and so we frequently waste it, as if we were the owners of an inexhaustible fortune. Later, as we get older, we would like to do what we did not do and we often find that our time has passed, and we no longer have the strength. Something similar happens with regard to God. We are so sure of His goodness that it seems to us it will never end and that is why we think we can always convert at any time and still yield the fruits of sanctity that He expects. The certainty that our faith gives us to know that a sinner can ask for forgiveness and be forgiven up to the very last minute, turns against God Himself, as if His goodness were His worst enemy, and, ultimately, ours too, because when we do not do the good that is due, we harm ourselves. It is as if God were equivalent to an indulgent father who ends up having a collection of spoiled and, therefore, naughty children. To avoid this, to correct our idea about God, to make us understand that Divine Love is not at odds with justice, is why Jesus told the parable of the fig tree that did not yield fruit.

God, in effect, gives us many opportunities, but these are not infinite. There will come a moment in the life of each one of us in which the opportunities to love will be over, and maybe then we will want to ask for an extension, one more hour of life, to do what we did not do for so many wasted days and years. Let us take advantage that our hearts are still beating in order to be thankful, in order to love.

Resolution: Am I fulfilling the good resolutions that I made? If the hour of death came for me, would I be prepared, in a state of grace and with my hands filled with good deeds?

From the Pastor's Desk

My dear parishioners,

The second Lenten tool for our spiritual journey is penance. Penance has some expressions such as abstinence and fasting and is rooted in a holy sadness.

There is a holy sadness and a bad sadness. For godly sorrow produces a salutary repentance without regret, but worldly sorrow produces death (2 Corinthians 7:10). Holy sadness stems from a sorrow for offending God's love and from hope in His divine mercy. This holy sadness does not afflict nor discourage the soul in pursuing God's love but increases the desire to love Him with soft and calm perseverance, and greater trust in His grace. Holy sadness leads to joy in God's compassion and brings detest to sin but does not disturb the soul in a way that leads it to despair and spiritual paralysis or sloth. Whereas -according to Saint Francis De Sales- bad sadness produces anguish, laziness, indignation, jealousy, envy and impatience, because it comes from the love of oneself, from the disappointment of not being perfect yet, and from not knowing that we are sinners who will struggle with our weaknesses until our last breath.

Penance is a virtue that belongs to justice, because it amends a harm done to God. Fast, abstinence and other ways of mortification are aimed at repairing a damage and educating our will in choosing to do His will.

I hope and pray that towards the end of this season we all had grown at least a little bit in greater freedom to love God as a result of mastering ourselves through the Lenten penances.

El segundo instrumento cuaresmal para nuestro camino espiritual es la penitencia. La penitencia tiene algunas expresiones, como la abstinencia y el ayuno, y hunde sus raíces en una santa tristeza.

Hay una tristeza santa y una tristeza mala. *La tris*teza vivida como Dios quiere produce arrepentimiento decisivo y saludable; en cambio, la tristeza de este mundo lleva a la muerte (2 Corintios 7:10). La santa tristeza nace del dolor por haber ofendido el amor de Dios y de la esperanza en su divina misericordia. Esta santa tristeza no aflige ni desanima al alma en la búsqueda del amor de Dios, sino que aumenta el deseo de amarle con suave y serena perseverancia, y una mayor confianza en su gracia. La santa tristeza lleva al gozo en la compasión de Dios y hace aborrecer el pecado, pero no perturba al alma de modo que la lleve a la desesperación y a la parálisis espiritual. Mientras que -según San Francisco De Sales - la mala tristeza produce angustia, pereza, indignación, celos, envidia e impaciencia, porque proviene del amor a uno mismo, de la decepción de no ser perfecto todavía y de no saber que somos pecadores que lucharemos con nuestras debilidades hasta nuestro último aliento.

La penitencia es una virtud que pertenece a la justicia, porque repara un daño hecho a Dios. El ayuno, la abstinencia y otras formas de mortificación tienen como objetivo reparar un daño y educar nuestra voluntad en la elección de hacer la voluntad de Dios.

Espero y deseo que, al final de esta Cuaresma, todos hayamos crecido al menos un poquito más en una mayor libertad para amar a Dios, como resultado de habernos dominado a nosotros mismos a través de las penitencias cuaresmales.
