# Word of Life

## 2nd Sunday of Easter: Witnesses of Life

*"Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name." (Jn 20: 30-31).*

St. John ends his Gospel by reminding his readers why he wrote it: to offer those interested in the new doctrine the essentials of the example and message of Jesus Christ and the result of applying that message to one's personal life. For John, it is not only a question of being in contact with the truth, but also of demonstrating that only the truth, which is Christ, sets us free and produces in the human being an authentic life worthy of that name.

If Christ is the way and the truth, He is also the life. Furthermore, He is the life only because He is the way and the truth. Or similarly: we will only be able to have life, and life in abundance, if we are united to Christ, if we imitate Christ. And the life that John is referring to is synonymous with happiness -not an absence of problems-, synonymous with the fullness of humanity and also with eternity, when death comes. But there is a condition to attain that life: to believe in Christ. Faith and the practice of the morals that are linked to that faith are indispensable conditions in order to enjoy the life that Christ grants us.

But for all this to be valid for each of us today, just as in the time of St. John, it is urgent to become witnesses of this before man. Everyone aspires to happiness but they do not find it because they look for it in the wrong ways. We must show them, by our example, that we are happy and that anyone can be happy simply by being united to Christ. Thus, sorrow and the cross become testimonials whenever we are able to smile despite them, thanks to the strength of God.

**Resolution:** Do not complain about problems, but rather take advantage of them to testify to the fact that you can be happy even while suffering, because you are united to Christ and because of the strength that He gives you to resist.

## From the Pastor's Desk



## Del Escritorio del Párroco

My dear parishioners,

The death of Pope Francis, the Vicar of Christ and Successor of Saint Peter, Apostle, has been the main news of the week worldwide.

It is our duty of love to pray for the dead, and in this case, most especially for the Holy Father Francis. That is why I would like to do a novena for his soul, starting on Sunday, April 27 at 3:30pm. We will bring the soul of Pope Francis before the Compassionate and Divine Heart of our Savior on the day where we celebrate His Divine Mercy, asking Him to be a merciful judge to he who was his Vicar on earth.

At the same time, we should start praying for the next Pope. There is much speculation among the media and within the Church about who will become the next Successor of Peter, but all these human calculations are precisely that, mere human speculations. The Lord has His own ways to work out His plan of salvation. There is a popular saying in the Vatican circles: "He who enters a conclave as Pope, he leaves as a cardinal." Regardless of how things are developing, we have the holy obligation to assist the cardinals with our prayers, so that they will let themselves be guided by the Holy Spirit in their deliberations and decisions.

Let us recall the promises made by the Lord Jesus to Saint Faustina for those who would pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy: "Whoever will recite it, they will receive great mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy." (Diary, 687) "When they say this Chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My father and the dying person, not as the Just Judge but as the Merciful Saviour." (Diary, 1541). "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion (in a state of grace on this day) shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (Diary, 699)

La muerte del Papa Francisco, Vicario de Cristo y Sucesor de San Pedro, Apóstol, ha sido la principal noticia de la semana en todo el mundo.

Es nuestro deber de amor rezar por los difuntos, y en este caso, muy especialmente por el Santo Padre Francisco. Por eso me gustaría hacer una novena por su alma, a partir del domingo 27 de abril a las 3:30 pm. Traeremos el alma del Papa Francisco ante el Corazón Compasivo y Divino de nuestro Salvador en el día en que celebramos su Divina Misericordia, pidiéndole que sea un juez misericordioso con quien fue su Vicario en la tierra.

Al mismo tiempo, debemos empezar a rezar por el próximo Papa. Hay muchas especulaciones entre los medios de comunicación y dentro de la Iglesia sobre quién será el próximo Sucesor de Pedro, pero todos estos cálculos humanos son precisamente eso, meras especulaciones humanas. El Señor tiene sus propios caminos para llevar a cabo su plan de salvación. Hay un dicho popular en los círculos vaticanos: "quien entra Papa, sale cardinal". Independientemente de cómo se desarrollen las cosas, tenemos la santa obligación de asistir a los cardenales con nuestras oraciones, para que se dejen guiar por el Espíritu Santo en sus deliberaciones y decisiones.

Recordemos las promesas hechas por el Señor Jesús a Santa Faustina para quienes recen la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia: "Quienquiera que la rece recibirá gran misericordia a la hora de la muerte. Los sacerdotes se la recomendarán a los pecadores como la última tabla de salvación. Hasta el pecador más empedernido, si reza esta coronilla una sola vez, recibirá la gracia de Mi misericordia infinita." (Diario 687) "Cuando recen esta coronilla junto a los moribundos, Me pondré entre el Padre y el alma agonizante no como el Juez justo sino como el Salvador misericordioso." (Diario 1541) "El alma que se confiese y reciba la Santa Comunión (en estado de gracia el día de su fiesta) obtendrá el perdón total de las culpas y de las penas." (Diario 699)

## Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

### CELEBRATION OF THE LIGHT

We will be back in the Atrium this coming Thursday, May 1, 2025. We will celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus with what we call the Celebration of the Light, because Jesus is the light of the World. We'll start with the blessing of our Paschal Candle. This is followed by a procession with the candle, the decoration of the prayer table in white with fresh flowers. We remain standing to listen to the Exultet, and then we all sit down to three readings. We stand up to sing the "ALLELUIA." After listening to the gospel of Matthew, we will be called by name to receive our own light, which after a short prayer, we will put on the table around our Paschal Candle. We sing as many songs as we want. This time is exiting the atrium. We sing "We are walking in the light of Christ, singing, praying, living, loving," and we go out to party. Yes! We celebrate! We are full of joy as we are so happy for Our Lord Jesus' victory. Alleluia, Alleluia, give thanks to our Risen Lord!

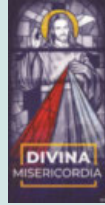

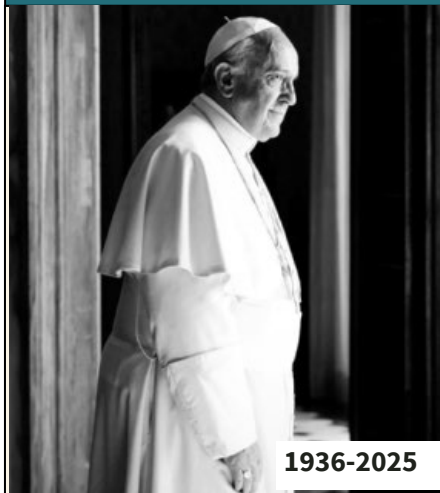
