Video Overview: The readings for today focus on God’s vision of marriage—a clearly hot topic in our culture. Today the Church invites us to peacefully meditate on what the Lord proposes to be the meaning of marriage. And as we’ll see, God created marriage to reveal the very meaning of our existence, and it is very good!

Featured Study: Marriage and Family by Dr. Scott Hahn. Strong relationships and marriages are of vital importance to individuals, the Church, and society overall, but real effort and wisdom are indispensable to making them last. In this focused presentation, Dr. Scott Hahn shares key principles that he has lived out in his own life. His advice is practical, challenging, and sometimes requires sacrifice, but it is sure to bear fruit and bring forth many blessings.

Topics of Interest:

It is impossible to be a Christian without seriously thinking about what the Church teaches. Our culture proclaims that truth does not exist, but our faith proclaims there is one truth, which is found in the Catholic Church. In a world determined not to tell anybody else what is right or wrong, believing that there is one truth can come across as hostile. It will take courage to believe the Gospel in our time. As Catholics, we cannot become relativists. What can you do this week to live the truth of the Gospel more fully?


