

<u>Video Overview</u>: Today we recall the Baptism of the Lord to remember our own. Our baptism isn't just an event from the past, but a present reality that impacts every aspect of our lives. **First,** baptism washes away original sin and fills us with grace, which is Christ's divine life in us. Baptism doesn't remove or cancel all the effects of Original Sin, and we still have a strong tendency, called concupiscence, toward sin. The **second** effect of baptism is that it emblazes an indelible mark on our souls. We become patterned after Jesus. Just as Jesus is the beloved son of God, we become adopted sons and daughters of God. Like Jesus, we can now refer to the first person of the Trinity as Our Father.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> Sometimes we think Baptism is just part of our past, our forgotten past or the importance may be lost on us, yet nothing could be further from the truth. Finally, at our Baptism, the Holy Spirit is breathed into our souls. From that moment on, the divine presence of the third person of the Trinity is in abiding communion with us in our hearts where we hear the Father's voice coming from heaven, we see the Son in the river, and we watch the Holy Spirit descend in the form of a dove. We are reminded because we have been baptized in the Name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

- Bequest: A bequest is a gift made through your will or trust.
 A bequest is the simplest type of planned gift for you to make and one of the easiest to implement.
- Charitable Remainder Trust (CRT): You transfer your cash or property to fund a trust that makes payments for your lifetime or a number of years and then passes what remains to your parish.
- Charitable Gift Annuity (CGA): You make a gift of cash or property to us and we agree to make fixed payments for one or two lives.
- Charitable Lead Trust (CLT): You transfer your cash or property to a trust that makes payments to your parish for a number of years and then passes the trust property to your family with no additional tax.
- ◆ IRA Charitable Rollover: If you are 70 ½ or older you can direct your IRA administrator to distribute a gift from your IRA to various diocesan ministries, including your parish.


