

<u>Video Overview:</u> Luke's Gospel recounts the beginning of Jesus' public ministry as He returns "in the power of the Holy Spirit" to Nazareth and goes to the synagogue and quotes the prophet, Isaiah; that the Spirit of the Lord has commissioned him to announce good news to the poor, news of release from captivity, recovery of sight for the blind, liberty to the oppressed—all in all, a year "of the Lord's favor." The Old Testament called this celebration the Year of Jubilee. Jesus applied that passage to himself as a new beginning for Israel. He is the one who launches the Jubilee Year for all who will hear Him.

<u>Featured Study</u>: Segment 5: Gifts of the Holy Spirit, this an excellent 25 minutes video and workbook.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> Today's readings speak of new beginnings in the relationship between God and his chosen people. Nehemiah is about the reconstruction of the city's defensive wall, reorganizing the priests to resume Temple worship and bringing the people into the process. He proclaims and **explains** the **book of the Law** to them. Because it's a new beginning after Israel's release from exile, and he exhorts the people to celebrate: "The joy of the Lord must be your strength." Jesus applies that passage to himself. In 1 Cor. Paul describes the Spirit's gifts are freely bestowed on the Church and are exercised in a spirit of unity, so that "there may be no discord in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another." Even after twenty centuries, the "year" of Jubilee is only beginning


