

<u>Video Overview</u>: The story of the prodigal son was a shocking story in the time of Jesus. The younger son asking for his inheritance is essentially telling his father, "I wish you were dead" because inheritances don't come until after a father's death. Then he squanders it on prostitutes looking for happiness in wealth and pleasure rather than in his relationship with his father. When the father sees him returning, he runs to meet him. Fathers were expected to act with dignity, so running to meet him would shame the family, and the action is completely incomprehensible to the older son. He has remained obedient to his father, since he viewed his father more as a master instead of a loving father. In this story the father goes out to meet both his sons and invite them into the feast—and into a better understanding of his love.

**<u>Featured Study:</u>** 7 Secrets of Divine Mercy. 5 star and incredible.

Topics of Interest: The story is a summary of the Christian understanding of who God is, our relation to him, and the process God has willed for our salvation. It explains the errors of Pharisaism through the attitude of the elder brother toward his brother. Pharisaism is defined as a rigid practice of the external forms of religion or morality without genuine regard for the proper reasons for doing so. A Pharisee doesn't recognize his own need of a savior, a blindness that can afflict both those too intent upon the following of rules as well as those who don't think that there ought to be any rules at all. Neither recognizes their need for mercy. Jesus doesn't free us of the obligation to act rightly when he mercifully gives us the grace to act rightly even when we don't deserve it. That is the lesson of Mercy.




