Private Adoration

The most important thing to realize about making a private Holy Hour is that you don't have to do anything. You don't have to say any particular prayers. All you have to do is be present to the One (Jesus) who is present in you.

Public Devotion

During times of Public Devotion, when the Blessed Sacramento is exposed, there should be prayers, praise & readings to direct the faithful to the worship of the Lord as well as to encourage a prayerful spirit.

How to Begin

You can begin by simply committing one hour (any Monday) to sit with Jesus inside the church in front of the Tabernacle. A Sign-up list is available inside the church. *Jesus must never be left alone.*
