The Resumption of the Public Celebration of Masses

Dear Families of St. John Vianney Parish,

Today I am calling to bring you good news! Bishop Soto has declared the Resumption of the Public Celebration of Masses effective **June 8**.

With that in mind, I am pleased to make the following announcements:

- Weekday Masses will start on **Monday, June 8 at 8am**.
- Weekend Masses will resume on June 13 & 14.
- Please note some changes to the Weekend Mass times to accommodate disinfecting after each Mass:
 - Saturday Vigil at: 5:30pm**
 - Sunday English Masses at: 8am, 10am & 12noon (12pm)**
 - Sunday Spanish Masses at: 2pm & 6pm**
- Physical & Social Distancing must be practiced. One-way traffic will be established in the Church and Hall. Follow the instructions or signs posted.
- Upon arrival, all parishioners will be screened for temperature.
- To facilitate contact tracing, all are required to provide their name and phone number.
- Families of same household & individuals must remain 6ft apart from each other.
- Attendance per Mass will be limited to a maximum of 100 persons, with overflow in the hall for a maximum of 100 persons. To avoid overcrowding, please consider attending one of the weekday Masses.
- You are encouraged to wear masks & gloves.
- Receiving Communion on the hand is highly recommended.
- Suspension of the Cup is still in place.
- Missalettes & hymnals will be removed.
- Hand sanitizers will be available.
- Each should consider his or her own health. Those over 65, those with pre-existing health conditions, and those who feels safer staying home are encouraged to stay home.
Dispensation from Sunday obligation will remain in force.

Your health & safety is our top priority. As we move into this new phase, let us strive to work together with love and care for everyone in our parish community. Please call the parish office if you have questions.
