
<u>Video Overview:</u> With whom does Jesus spend most of his time? They aren't the so-called "holy" people, but ordinary sinners like you and me. People who mess up, who need healing, who can't seem to get their act together. Why does Jesus want to be with sinners? It's because his whole goal is to fulfill the Father's plan, not by being a Messiah in the worldly sense,



but by becoming the Messiah who bears all the consequences of sin by dying on the cross. That's what his mission, his entire reason for becoming man, was all about: to step into the place of sinners. He became a man so that he could know what it was like to be human in order to save humanity. Jesus had a unique mission, one only he could fulfill. But have you ever stopped to consider that you have a unique mission as well? One only you can fulfill? It's true. And just as Jesus was able to complete his mission through the power of the Holy Spirit, we receive that very same Holy Spirit when we are baptized and confirmed. Through the power of the Spirit given to us in the sacraments, we are given the power to obey the word of God when we are anointed to carry out our mission as beloved sons and daughters of the Father.

Featured Study: Reborn; Entering the Mystery: The Rite Explained.

Topics of Interest: This wonderful feast of the Baptism of the Lord is part of a triptych of mysteries in the mind of the Church. In the Liturgy of the Hours it says, "Three mysteries mark this holy day: today the star leads the Magi to the infant Christ; today water is changed into wine for the wedding feast; today Christ wills to be baptized by John in the river Jordan to bring us salvation." That prayer suggests that the mystery of the Magi celebrated last Sunday on the Epiphany is continued in another "epiphany" in this feast of the Baptism of the Lord. That word in the Greek means "a showing forth" and the thing shown here is the Christological mystery of our faith, that Jesus is the Incarnate Son of God and the second Person of the Most Holy Trinity. All three divine Persons are present in the tableau that we see both here and in Luke's gospel, the voice of the Father, the dove as a sign of the Holy Spirit and, of course, the presence of the Son in the waters of the Jordan. By our Baptism we enter that mystery of the Son, overshadowed by the Spirit we become the favored sons and daughters of the Father.




