

<u>Video Overview:</u> On this day we encounter the Magi, (Royal Persian Priests), who came to worship the baby, Jesus. They see a great star in the sky, signifying the birth of a great ruler and follow it to the town of Bethlehem. Matthew tells us that they **prostrated** themselves before the child Jesus. **This is a significant detail** in the story because these Magi were important men, **serving in royal** courts in the East. And yet these foreigners **bowed down** to worship a Jewish baby in Israel. The Church Fathers recognized that this scene shows how the child who came to be the king of Israel was also the king of the whole world.



<u>Featured Study:</u> "Were the Magi at Jesus' Birth." An enlightening view of the facts explaining the different viewpoints of the Gospels and how they come together to make a complete story. Excellent.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> Another detail is that the Magi bring the new king Jesus three gifts: gold for a King, frankincense for worship (He's God), and myrrh points to **Christ's mortality**. What can this mean for our lives? As we approach Jesus on this day of Epiphany— and on every day—we want to approach him in great reverence as our Lord and our King. Like the Magi we bow down before him as our king, we recognize his divinity and worship him, and we bring the gift of self-sacrifice, just as the Magi offered him myrrh.

Lord God of heaven and earth,


You revealed Your only begotten son to every nation by the guidance of a star.






