Video Overview: Today we will encounter a man who has been seeking to follow the commandments since he was a young boy and now he thinks he has it all together in order to have eternal life. But when Jesus invites him to something deeper, something more, he is crushed, as he will have to “start over” in some ways. Are you willing to take the next step to growing closer to Jesus?

Featured Study: In both the Old and New Testaments, God calls his people to become more like him. In his Letter to the Philippians, Paul paints a vivid picture of how to pursue this goal of learning to give to others as we do ourselves. We are not called to strive after holiness in some abstract way, but to do so by imitating Christ—specifically in his sacrificial gift of self. It is a call to pour ourselves out as an offering to God, just as Jesus did on the Cross. Embracing this "loss of all things," Paul tells us, is the only way to "gain Christ and be found in him" (Philippians 3:8-9).

Topics of Interest: Challenge yourself this week to empty your life of worldliness and make room for Jesus. Give something away, not something buried in your closet that you don't use, but something that you use frequently, that would be a sacrifice. Maybe it's a piece of clothing or your coffee money for the week. Also, turn off the TV and computer screens in your house one night. Take time to pray as a family or on your own with the extra time you gain without the entertainment.

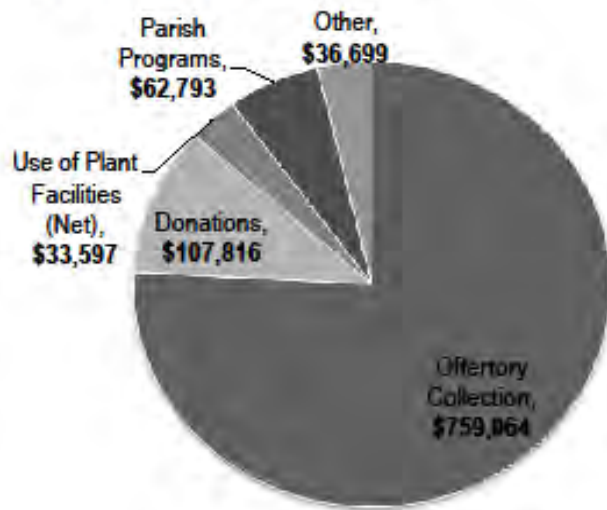

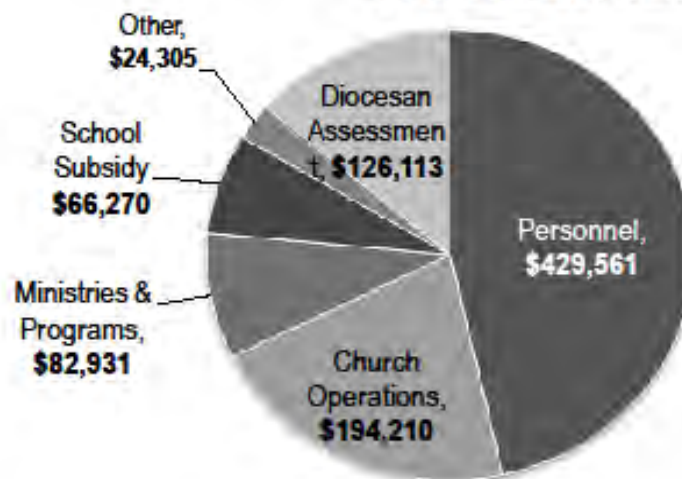

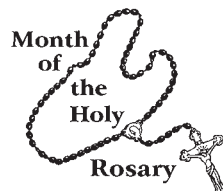
