<u>Video overview:</u> Have you ever longed for a role, a job, or place in life, for which you would give just about anything to have? And then, after you finally got what you wanted, you realized that it was more than or different from what you were expecting? In today's Gospel, two of Jesus's disciples ask for a huge role - to sit at his right and left side in his eternal kingdom, and thereby suffer in a similar passion and death to that of Christ's. They cannot imagine the suffering that they would undergo to have this desire fulfilled, however. With gentleness and love, Jesus tells them he will give them some of what they ask for, but not all. Hearing that we can't do it all or have it all, requires deep humility. Are you ready to acquire profound humility?

Featured study: Can you trust GOD? Since the fall of our first parents, humanity has been tempted to mistrust God the Father's love for us.

Topic of Interest: Humility, service, and suffering. All three come together beautifully as we seek to imitate Jesus Christ. We must be humble in order to serve and accept suffering. Service often requires some suffering on our part as we lay our lives down for those we are serving. At the heart of our service is the intense love of Christ that we want to kindle within us and share with others. In which area do you struggle the most - humility, service, or accepting suffering? Take some time to ask Jesus to give you the grace to grow in this area so that you can be a servant-leader, sharing his love with those you encounter. In this Gospel passage, James and John are proud in their bold request to sit on the left and right side of Christ. Nevertheless, this request may come from a deeper desire, namely, to spend eternity with Christ. What do you desire to ask of the Lord? Consider whether your requests simply come from pride, or if you are truly and humbly seeking the will of God. Ask for those things that you desire, and then abandon everything to God's divine providence, which might not involve those things for which you are asking.



Protocol for Indoor Masses

- Individuals who are sick or have a vulnerable health condition or are caring for someone with a vulnerable health condition are not obligated to attend the Eucharist on Sunday or other obligatory solemnities.
- All the faithful are encouraged to receive the COVID-19 vaccination when available. Please consult your doctor regarding any personal health concerns.




