<u>Video Overview</u>: In today's Gospel, two of Jesus' disciples ask for a huge role—to partake of Jesus' passion and death and sit at his right and left side in his eternal kingdom. They have no idea the suffering that they would be partaking in in order to have this desire fulfilled though. With gentleness and love, Jesus tells them he will give them some of what they ask for, but not all.

<u>Featured Study</u>: Saint Francis of Assisi. Brother Thomas called Francis an "alter Christos" who was like "a holy mirror of the sanctity of the Lord, and an image of His perfection." This film tells the story of his whole life. We see the wealthy young Francis, who dreamt of being a great knight, but becomes transformed by a mystical experience of the Lord, who asked Francis to "rebuild my Church." God asked him to leave all his possessions and unite himself with his "Lady Poverty," serving the poor and outcast. Francis becomes a "troubadour of the Lord" and a "jester of God" who attracts great numbers of men to join his new monastic order, helping to renew the Church and spread the Gospel.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> Serve fearlessly this week. If you feel called to be part of a ministry at Church, take the leap of faith and volunteer. Find a way each day to serve your family or a co-worker. Do not be afraid of the demands of service, for it is when we give ourselves fully in sacrifice that we are most closely united with Jesus's Passion.

#### Dear Friends in Christ:

Several months ago, I wrote to you about the shame I felt over the sickening, repulsive actions revealed in the Pennsylvania Grand Jury report and the actions of Archbishop Theodore McCarrick. My heart, like yours, remains heavy as we continue to confront the painful, shameful evil perpetrated by priests and bishops who betrayed the trust placed in them by the People of God.

These vicious sins caused lasting pain for victims. The depth of this betrayal is difficult to fathom and painful to consider. But, I must confront it. I cannot wish it away or *ever* consider the issue closed.

I apologize for the grave harm done to these victims -- for the wounds inflicted by the abusers as well as for the failures to act in their defense when there was a duty and obligation to do so. I must own this shameful reality of our past and devote myself to atoning for it.

A fundamental step in confronting the past is to provide a public, transparent accounting of it. For this reason, I will release to the public and publish on our website the names of priests in our diocese who have been credibly accused of abusing children and young people. This review will include all priests who have served in our diocese over the past 50 years, whether permanently assigned here, visiting from another diocese, or members of a religious order.

Initially, I had hoped this list would be prepared quickly and released by the end of this year. It has become clear, however, that completing this task with transparency and confidence will require outside, independent expertise as well as additional time.

I am pleased to announce that we will have the assistance of the consulting firm recognized as the best there is at tackling this task and ensuring that dioceses live up to their promises of accountability. The firm is headed by <a href="Dr. Kathleen McChesney">Dr. Kathleen McChesney</a>, a former executive assistant director of the FBI and a founding member of the Office of Child Protection at the US Conference of Catholic Bishops. Dr. McChesney's firm will have complete access to our files and the complete cooperation and assistance of myself and our diocesan staff. I anticipate the list will be finalized and released in March.

This reckoning with the past will be difficult for the faithful and particularly for victims of abuse. Some will be heartbroken. Some will be angry to learn that sinful acts were perpetrated in a parish or school they trusted with their children or grandchildren. Victims may find that seeing these names brings back the horrors of abuse and reopens old wounds.

I ask each of you to pray for the victims of abuse – always. As their pain is ongoing, so must our prayers for them be. This is not something we do for a period of time, but from this time forward.

The faith of everyone in our parishes – laity, religious, and clergy – has been shaken by these shameful crimes. May the intercession of our Blessed Mother Mary strengthen us for the journey ahead with the mercy and wisdom of her Son, Jesus.

Restoring the trust God's People put in the Church will be the work not of weeks or months or even years. Rather, it must be our never-ending mission. The present sorrowful saga is a painful reminder of the Christian call to continually make reparation and seek redemption. I have dedicated myself to this endeavor. I humbly rely on your prayers and patience as we face this together.

#### Estimados Amigos en Cristo:

Hace unos meses, les escribí sobre la pena que sentí por las acciones asquerosas y repulsivas que se revelaron en el informe del Gran Jurado de Pensilvania y las acciones del Arzobispo Theodore McCarrick. Mi corazón, como el tuyo, permanece herido mientras continuamos enfrentando el doloroso y vergonzoso mal perpetrado por sacerdotes y obispos que traicionaron la confianza depositada en ellos por el Pueblo de Dios.

Estos pecados causaron un dolor duradero para las víctimas. La profundidad de esta traición es dificil de comprender y dolorosa de considerar. Pero, debo enfrentarlo. No puedo desear que desaparezca o considerar el tema cerrado.

Pido disculpas por el grave daño hecho a estas víctimas -- por las heridas infligidas por los abusadores y por no actuar en su defensa cuando existía el deber y la obligación de hacerlo. Debo reconocer esta vergonzosa realidad de nuestro pasado y dedicarme a repararlo.

Un paso fundamental para enfrentar el pasado es proporcionar un recuento público y transparente de dicho pasado. Por esta razón, daré a conocer al pueblo y publicaré en nuestro sitio web los nombres de los sacerdotes de nuestra diócesis que han sido acusados creíblemente de abusar de niños y jóvenes. Este reporte incluirá a todos los sacerdotes acusados que hayan servido en nuestra diócesis durante los últimos 50 años, ya sea asignados permanentemente aquí, visitando de otra diócesis o miembros de una orden religiosa.

Inicialmente, tenía la esperanza que esta lista se preparara rápidamente y se publicara a fines de este año. Sin embargo, ha quedado claro que para completar este trabajo con transparencia y confianza se requiere experiencia externa e independiente y más tiempo.

Les anuncio que contaremos con la ayuda de un conjunto de consultoría reconocida como la mejor en asumir este trabajo y asegurar que las diócesis cumplan con sus promesas de mostrar responsabilidad. La firma está dirigida por la Dra. Kathleen McChesney, quien fue directora asistente ejecutiva del FBI y miembro fundadora de la Oficina de Protección de Niños en la Conferencia Episcopal Católica de los Estados Unidos. El equipo de la Dra. McChesney tendrá acceso total a nuestros archivos y la completa cooperación y asistencia mía y de mi personal diocesano. Espero que la lista sea finalizada y publicada en marzo.

Este reencuentro con el pasado será dificil para los fieles y en particular para las víctimas de abuso. Algunos quedarán disilusionados. Algunos tendrán coraje al saber que se cometieron actos viciosos en una parroquia o escuela en la cual confiaron a sus hijos o nietos. Al ver estos nombres, las victimas quizás revivirán de nuevo el horror del abuso y reabrirán las viejas heridas.

Les pido a cada uno de ustedes que oren por las víctimas de abuso - siempre. Como su dolor continúa, también nuestras oraciones por ellos deben continuar. Esto no es algo que haremos por un período de tiempo, sino de ahora en adelante.

Los Fieles de todos en nuestras parroquias – laicos, religiosos y clero - han sido lastimados por estos crímenes vergonzosos. Que la intercesión de nuestra Santísima Madre María nos fortalezca para el camino a seguir con la misericordia y sabiduría de su Hijo Jesús.

Recuperar la confianza que el pueblo de Dios puso en la Iglesia no será una tarea de semanas, meses o años. Más bien, debe ser nuestra misión interminable. La presente saga dolorosa es un recordatorio triste del llamado cristiano a reparar continuamente y buscar la redención. Me he dedicado a este esfuerzo. Confio humildemente en sus oraciones y paciencia mientras enfrentamos esto juntos.


