Video Overview: The imagery of sight and blindness pervades today’s readings. The Church uses this metaphor to help us understand how we are blinded by sin and need to follow the light of Christ. Yet, modern society defines freedom as doing anything we want, as long as we don’t hurt anyone else; i.e. there is no sin as long as it only affects ourselves. Catholics understand we are only free as far as we are able to do the good freely. We grow when we resist evil and choose good. Moreover, sin is not private, because it gravely offends our relationship with God, it hurts our union with others, and we only hurt ourselves by sinning. Through the light of Jesus we are able to overcome our blindness. Do we have the spiritual strength to let go of our petty attachments, and choose Christ above all else?

Featured Study: Opening the Word, Year A – Ordinary Time weeks 22-34, 30th Sunday in Ordinary time October 29, 2017. Find this in the search block and use the study guide. It is impressive as we learn to give it up for Jesus.

Topics of Interest: In the Gospel story this week, we see Bartimaeus throw aside his cloak, spring up, and turn to Jesus. Why did he need to throw aside his cloak, that is the question you need to answer? Many things in our lives hold us back from fully trusting in Jesus. What material object in your life prevents you from genuinely seeking healing from Jesus, and how can you strive to “throw it aside” to grow your faith in Jesus this week?

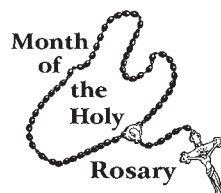
