

Dear St. John Vianney Parishioners,

I am writing to invite you to prayerfully consider donating to St. John Vianney School's **Annual Fund**. Every year generous donors contribute money to the school's **Annual Fund** to support specific student-related needs. In past years, your donations have supported the integration of technology in the teaching/learning process and improved campus security. This year we would very much like to refresh the grassy fields that the students use during their P.E. classes, recesses, and when practicing for sports.

St. John Vianney School students know how lucky they are to have grassy fields for their use. While parking lots are great for many playground games, students, teachers, and coaches recognize the potential of the fields. Unfortunately, our fields are full of stumps/roots that need to be ground and removed, divots/ruts that need to be filled, and holes from past irrigation issues which limit their use. The scope of the work will require heavy equipment, professionals, and many helping hands. This where you come in!

Every dollar donated to the Annual Fund will be used for the specified purpose of improving the fields. Depending on the amount of money donated, we would also like to repair/replace basketball hoops, add play features to the TK/K and 1-4 play areas, build an 1/8 mile decomposed granite track, and build long jump and high jump practice facilities. We work very hard to find the best pricing to help stretch every donation to its fullest potential, so you can be confident that donation will be carefully managed.

If you are near that magic age of 70 ½, you may already know that the tax law requires you to take mandatory traditional IRA payouts each year. Tapping your IRA, of course, means you will also get stuck with resulting income tax bills. One way to avoid paying taxes on your payout is to donate IRA money directly to a non-profit organization. The gift stays out of your adjusted gross income only if you make a direct transfer from your IRA to the non-profit organization, in this case, St. John Vianney School. Ask your IRA administrator what steps you need to take because the procedures vary from firm to firm.
