

<u>Video Overview:</u> When we start to examine our lives to see if Jesus is truly Lord over our whole lives, we might begin to observe a pattern. We often reject Jesus as Lord because we reject the Cross; because we don't want to suffer. We are afraid of embracing the Cross because we don't believe that it will bring us true and lasting joy. As Christians, we long for God's Kingdom to come. And if it comes through the Cross, we must learn to long for the Cross as the saints did, not simply for the sake of suffering, but because it provides us the opportunity to suffer with Christ. With God's grace, we can learn to offer our sufferings in union with Christ's sufferings on the Cross, rather than ignoring it, repressing it, or fleeing from it. We can train our eyes to look for the Cross and embrace it out of love for Jesus, thus making our prayer real for God's Kingdom to come.

<u>Featured Study</u>: THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING. In 1925, Pope Pius XI established this celebration as an antidote to secularism, which was society's movement away from awareness and recognition of God's primacy.

Topics of Interest: It is important for us to have an appropriate theological understanding of the "Kingdom of God." The Kingdom of God is not of this world, which means that God reigns as King in Heaven. The Church is God's visible presence on earth, but we are always on a pilgrimage toward our heavenly patria, our heavenly fatherland. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "All the things of this world are not yet subjected to him" (no. 680). We live in the age of the "one last assault by the powers of evil" before the ultimate triumph of Christ's kingdom. This means that our pilgrim Church also "carries the mark of this world which will pass" and groans with eager expectation for Jesus's Second Coming, always praying, "Come, Lord Jesus!"


