<u>Video Overview:</u> The Christian Faith has many paradoxes, i.e. three Persons in one God; God made something out of nothing; God's mother is one of his creations, etc. Most of us ignore the discrepancies but they're not meant to be ignored but to be defended, and not to be kept secret, they were unveiled by God himself. One of our greatest mysteries is that there can be profound joy even in the depths of the worst suffering, which is what the Church draws to our attention on Gaudete Sunday. In the season of penance and waiting, we find ourselves celebrating a day completely devoted to joy! How is it possible to "rejoice always," when St. Paul tells us, we know the suffering that this world brings? The Church shares that in today's readings in Isaiah, Mary, and St. Paul. In each case, someone lives in joy while waiting for the Lord. We are still awaiting his second coming while we're still in exile waiting to be taken home to Heaven. Reflect and discover how these biblical figures always rejoiced in the Lord, while still anticipating the fulfillment of his promises, and how you can do the same.

Featured Study: God comes to meet us. Whew, good movie.

Topics of Interest: John the Baptist is a larger light in St. John's Gospel as the witness to the Messiah. Jesus "was not the light but came to testify to the light" (Jn 1:8). Scholars note; John's Gospel begins with the same phrase as Genesis: "In the beginning," suggesting the incarnated Christ is also a new creation. John in 2 chapters mentions a series of days that add up to seven in all! The phrase "the next day" suggests the passing of four days, and the story of the wedding feast at Cana begins with the words, "On the third day," suggesting the passing of three more days. John describes the beginning of the re-creation in Christ, just as Genesis describes creation itself in a series of seven days. John describes the Messiah as "one among you whom you do not recognize" (John 1:26). This idea of God among us is a central theme of both the Old and New Covenants. God dwelt among his people during the Exodus from Egypt, in the Tabernacle, and in the Temple. Of course, Jesus is our Emmanuel, "God with us," in a special way during Advent. Most profoundly, he is "one among us" in the Eucharist, under the humble form of bread and wine, and as such is often one whom we "do not recognize." Each Holy Communion, then, is a little advent, another coming of Jesus, and so the Advent season ought to teach us how to be better prepared to greet Christ in each Mass.




