<u>Video Overview:</u> Who hasn't felt discouraged at some point in life; just as John the Baptist did when languishing in prison? He was wondering if all he said and done had any meaning after he recognized Jesus wasn't the Warrior-King to overthrow the Romans and restore Israel to glory. John's faith was shaken when he told his followers to ask Jesus, "Are you the one?" Jesus tells them to look at what he has done: healing the sick, raising the dead, bringing the good news to the poor. John immediately recognized those actions as the ones Isaiah prophesized. By focusing on those deeds, John knew Jesus was the one. Even though the plan wasn't going the way John thought it would, he could be comforted by knowing God was powerfully at work. Just as we too recognize also that the mission of Jesus is not to establish an earthly kingdom, but to restore us to the fullness of life.

Featured Study (Use FORMED search tool): Advent Reflections: Preparing for the Birth of Our Savior with Tim Gray

Topics of Interest: Jesus cites, the signs of the coming messianic age from Isaiah 35, as proof that his ministry is it. "Blessed is the one who takes no offense at me." Jesus makes a similar point when addressing the crowds after John's messengers depart. He asks, "What did you go out into the desert to see? A reed swayed by the wind?" The reed, a symbol for King Herod, suggested Herod had made a truce with the Romans, which would turn to Israel's advantage. Just as God had become a stumbling block to Israel then, Jesus would be now, because Jesus would not bend to the current political wind, as had Herod and the Jews who collaborated with Rome to maintain their power. God's people must turn to the messianic King who's coming and reign is signaled not by the rich trappings of a royal court, but by the lone voice of a prophet crying in the wilderness proclaiming the good news to the poor.


