


<u>Video Overview:</u> Today is Gaudete, or Rejoice Sunday—and the prophet Zephaniah opens with a threefold call to joy, "Shout for joy... sing joyfully.... Be glad and exult with all your heart." Israel rejoiced in the presence of

her saving God, but this joy is made complete in the coming of Jesus, and we too are called to rejoice in the presence of Jesus. In Philippians, St. Paul shares with us the secret to Christian joy: It is not merely an emotion that comes and goes, but a choice to rejoice by remembering all that God has done for us. In Luke we're reminded: Repentance is the preparation for receiving God's gift of salvation. The crowds flocking to John are a testimony to the deep hunger and desire in man's heart for God, and John answers this hunger with simple instructions: Put your life in order. The works of charity and justice that John encourages are not salvation itself, but they prepare the heart for salvation, which, in turn, opens us to the joy that God alone can provide.

<u>Featured Study</u>: Session 3: H.A.B.I.T.S. It takes discipline and perseverance to be Jesus's disciple. But where do Discipline and perseverance come from? In this session, we will discuss H.A.B.I.T.S., an acronym for those key disciplines that help us grow in our relationship with God and become more like Jesus.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> Read Zephaniah 3 about the wickedness of Israel and the restoration of Israel. Then reread it with the knowledge you have of what Christ has brought to us. That is the joy of the Gospel and topic to pursue. What was it Jesus brought us that is spoken of in Zephaniah.


