<u>Video overview:</u> Have you ever driven on a zigzag road? If you have, then you know how long it takes to get somewhere. It would be so much faster if you could just take a straight path to your destination. In today's reading, we are told, "The winding roads shall be made straight." But the real question is why roads, especially the road to God, get crooked in the first place. The answer is simple: First, we follow our will, and then we veer back to God. But that doesn't last and we go our own selfish way again. Then we decide to do it God's way, but before long, we are wandering off down our own road of bad intentions again. We do this over and over, and pretty soon we have created a very zigzag path indeed. How do we make our path straight? By following God's will wholeheartedly. Our Father gently calls us to repent from our crooked paths and return home to him. He reaches out and offers to help us find our way directly back to him. But it's up to us if we are going to accept his offer to return from our self-imposed exile and "come back rejoicing, carrying [our] sheaves."

Featured study: Day 9, a pivotal minor character.

Topic of Interest: Luke shows a remarkable interest in tying together the Old Covenant and the New Covenant in Christ. Luke is believed to have been a Gentile, and it's likely that the time he spent sharing the missionary travels of St. Paul gave him profound insight into the intimate connection between Judaism and its fulfillment in Christ. In this week's reading, John the Baptist's ministry is introduced; he's the last prophet of the Old Covenant and the first of the New Covenant. John is the great precursor of the Messiah that the prophet Isaiah had foretold. He is, in fact, the precursor of Christ in our souls this Advent season. In a homily on Luke, the early Church theologian, Origen says of the Baptist, "I think that the mystery of John is still being carried on in the world. If a man is to believe in Jesus Christ, the spirit and power of John must first come into his soul and prepare for the Lord a perfect people, make the rough ways of the heart plain, make the crooked straight. Even now the spirit and power of John precede the coming of our Lord and Savior."



Saint John Vianney Ladies' Retreat – January 7-9, 2022

January 10-12, 2020, was the largest ever in attendance, causing several our ladies to not join us. We missed them but encouraged them to avail themselves to another weekend. Now is the best time for us all to make the decision to attend with SJV the women's retreatants, January 7-9, 2022, always the second weekend in the New Year. The SJV men's retreat weekend is February 4-6, 2022. The best possible way to begin your New Year in Christ. Perhaps also, to consider a Christmas gift for a family member or friend too. This gift, a weekend away with like-minded Catholic people at Christ the King Retreat Center in Citrus Heights, CA. This year's retreat, offers the opportunity to ponder God's Dream for us and the world. If you've been wondering how to make sense of the last year and a half, we will be stepping back to look at the bigger picture- the state of our church and our country, and, of course, our own personal lives- all through the lens of Sacred Scripture and storytelling.

This year's theme is "God's Dream-for our world", The Bible as Story. The seven-member retreat team, consisting of three Priests, one Deacon, one Brother, one lay administer and one lay teacher, fully engage us with lively, religious presentations on the theme, including personal stories and many jokes. You will find a well thought out weekend, with two Masses, morning and evening chapel prayer, confession time and private consultations. There will be a silent time, great meals, professional massage, also communicating with nature on the 41 acres, an outdoor labyrinth and Stations of the Cross, including two flocks of turkeys (some are almost white) and at least four deer, amongst the oak trees.

The Passionist Priests are known for their retreats and hospitality world wide. St. Paul of the Cross began the order 300 years ago. Christ the King Retreat Center on Van Maren in Citrus Heights, held it's first men's retreat in May of 1950. Lloyd and Connie Lagerstrom and family have been attending various activities at the Retreat Center since the 1970's, when they lived at Beale AFB for over seven years. It then too was, "Our church home away from home". "May the Passion of Jesus Christ be always in our Hearts".
