Video Overview: The secular world begins to celebrate during the holidays, but we are asked to consider our sinfulness. John the Baptist calls "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" It might seem that John is talking about sin, but he is calling for us to "repent." To repent is not just to realize that we have done bad things, or to berate ourselves continually for our errors. True Repentance means that we confess our failures by doing those attributes and actions that involve an honest examination of conscience and a firm commitment to change . John accuses the Pharisees and Sadducees of being a "brood of vipers." He is, in very dramatic fashion, they are not practicing the word of God that they preach. He is calling them to make the dramatic change that lies at the heart of true repentance. We are asked to do the same thing. What gives us hope is that Jesus will bring with him the Holy Spirit. This is one of the reasons the Church includes this reading during Advent— for it is the Holy Spirit who breaks through the walls of our sinfulness and pride. The Holy Spirit illuminates our hearts and only through this illumination we can set our feet on a new path, which leads to the abundant life that Jesus has promised is waiting for us.

Featured Study (Use FORMED search tool): Advent Reflections: Preparing for the Birth of Our Savior with Tim Gray.

Topics of Interest: St. Augustine teaches that John's birth to elderly parents (Elizabeth and Zechariah) represents the Mosaic Covenant, whereas his leaping for joy while still in his mother's womb at the Visitation of Mary suggests the New Covenant of the Messiah. In his appearance and actions, John sums up the whole of the Old Testament. His clothing is the same as the OT prophet Elijah who calls Israel out into the desert for purification just as Moses did, and prepares the people for the new Promised Land by the new Joshua (Yeshua=Jesus). His diet consists of locusts, which are symbolic of pestilence, and honey, which is the food of the Promised Land.
