Video Overview: Simon Peter had been up-all-night fishing unsuccessfully, but Jesus tells him to go out and try one more time. It's easy to imagine how a seasoned fisherman like Simon Peter might resist the suggestion. But, in the end, he agrees. Perhaps he didn't expect to catch anything. So, we can imagine his surprise when his obedience yields more than he could possibly imagine. In that, we have a valuable lesson. Through prayer and Scripture study we can find how to have obedience to the word, our faith actually grows as we prove it to ourselves what it is to sacrifice our lusts with obedience to God.

Featured Study: Episode 4: *Bring about the Obedience of Faith.* Faith is not merely an intellectual assent to God; it is the full submission of both our intellect and our will to the "Will of God."

Topics of Interest: Simon says to Jesus, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord" (Luke 5:8, RSV). But Jesus still calls Peter, with all his weaknesses, to follow him and to share the Gospel with others—to become "fishers of men." And he calls us to do the same, even in the face of whatever doubts, fears, and weaknesses we may experience. Like Peter, we are often reluctant. We feel unworthy to accept such a great responsibility. But Jesus doesn't let us use our unworthiness as an excuse any more than he allowed Peter to do so. He tells us, as he does the fishermen of Galilee, "Don't be afraid!" He will be with us in all we do to spread the Gospel.

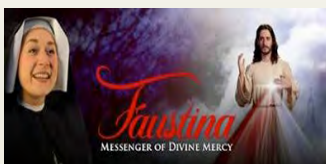
