100th Anniversary of Fatima

On the 11th day of the month of February, we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes who appeared to St. Bernadette eighteen times in the year 1858.

Keeping that in mind, as we anticipate the 100th anniversary of the six apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, we see that in Lourdes, she asked for "prayer and penance." The Grotto of Massabielle has served as a shrine of pilgrimage for millions of people as a place of prayer and penance. It is a sacred place where the physically infirm and the spiritually broken come in faith and hope seeking healing. It is, at the Grotto, where Our Blessed Mother came down from Heaven to gift us, her children, with the grace of hope.

It was during one of the apparitions that Our Lady told St. Bernadette that she requested that a chapel be built and that the faithful should come in procession to the Grotto. The "procession," a symbol of pilgrimage and penance, and a symbol of our faith journey, is a focal point of devotion of this special place.

Our Lady's call to prayer and penance will resound again within the Fatima Apparitions of 1917. At Lourdes, it is St. Bernadette who will shout out to those gathered at the Grotto: "Penance! Penance! Penance!" At Fatima, it is the Angel, depicted in the Third Secret of Fatima, who will cry out to all of humanity: "Penance! Penance! Penance!"

In 1916, the year before Our Lady appeared to the three shepherd children, the Angel of Peace taught them a prayer to strengthen their faith, and in reparation, to pray for those who have no faith. Let us take this prayer to heart and share it with others as we acknowledge upcoming months (May - Oct.) of the Apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima.

Below are the prayers the Angel of Peace taught the Shepherd Children:

"My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love you. I ask pardon of you for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love you." (The Angel instructed the Shepherd Children to repeat the prayer three times.)

"Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference with which He Himself is offended. And, through the infinite merits of His most Sacred Heart, and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of You the conversion of poor sinners."

Throughout this year, let us embrace with faith Our Heavenly Mother's message of "prayer and penance." Our Lady of the Rosary of Fatima, pray for us.




