Video Overview: Take a moment now and close your eyes. Imagine that you are with the disciples as Jesus begins to talk. You hear him say, "If anyone strikes you on the cheek, offer the other also; and from anyone who takes away your coat do not withhold even your shirt."

Featured Study: Anger and Forgiveness. Catholic Psychologist and Deacon, Bob McDonald, provides the spiritual prescription to turn your cheek and overcome sinful anger.

Topics of Interest: *Love your enemy and do good to those who persecute you.* Two of the most challenging statements Jesus ever said, and the basic requirements of being a disciple of Christ. Why would Jesus demand such a high standard of his followers? Isn't this kind of love and forgiveness extremely difficult, almost impossible? Humanly speaking, yes. But with God all things are possible, and the Lord wants to transform our hearts to enable us to love others with the love He has for us. The first reading and Gospel reading for this week reveal the kind of love that overcomes all things, even hatred, and fear. The love of God that Jesus reveals in his death and Resurrection, the fact that He loved us even when we were His enemies in sin is the same love that we as followers of Christ are to witness to the entire world. Christians are not to win converts by fear or coercion or the sword. Like our Master and Savior, we conquer overwhelmingly with our love, a love so radical that even the enemies of Christians, when they are loved by those they hate, cannot help but be moved.

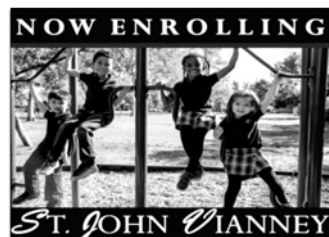

COLLECTION OF BLESSED PALMS

As Lent approaches, we invite you to return the palms you received at Palm Sunday last year (or previous years) so that they may be disposed of properly. As noted in Canon Law, blessed items are not to be discarded in the trash, but treated with respect (cf. #1171).



Thus, in order to assist you in your reverent disposal of these sacramentals, there are collection baskets located at the doors of the Church and the parish office for you to return your palms. These Palms will be ritually burned, some of the ashes may be used for the distribution of ashes for Ash Wednesday, and the remainder will be returned to the earth.
