

Video overview: Evangelization is not a job assigned only to bishops, priests, and religious brothers and sisters. Pope Paul VI insisted that the "task of evangelizing all people constitutes the essential mission of the Church." And by "the Church," he meant the Church as a whole—everyone, including the laity. But for many of us, the work of evangelization sounds scary. We might be thinking, "Me? Evangelize? How do I do that?" We might even be wondering what evangelization means and gives us some answers because Jesus presents a formula for the best way to evangelize and spread the Gospel message. This formula involves both a giving and receiving of Christ's mission. We give when we spread his message with joy and gratitude, which we receive when we can rest in the peace of Christ, knowing that we have fully accepted God's words in our hearts. What Jesus is telling the disciples, and by extension all of us, is that we are to bring to all the nations the blessing of God that had been given first to Israel. When we do that, we share in God's own peace and joy. How peaceful we are says how much we have accepted Jesus in our hearts. The extent to which we share our faith is the extent to which we share the joy of God.

Featured study: What is Love? A second option is Chapter 14:#4:Give

Reflection: In addition to the Twelve, Jesus also appoints seventy or seventy-two others to serve, we might say, as "advance men" for his own ministry. But by their very number we see that the "kingdom of God" that Jesus instructs them to announce means that the role of Israel—especially through a messianic figure that Isaiah calls the servant of Yahweh—to be "a light to the nations" is coming to fulfillment (Isaiah 42:6 and 49:6). In Jewish tradition, seventy (or seventy-two) is the number of the nations descended from Noah and his sons after the flood (Genesis 10) and the number of the offspring of Jacob who went with him into Egypt (Exodus 1:5). Deuteronomy 32:8 even seems to connect these two, saying, "When the Most High gave to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of men, he fixed the bounds of the peoples according to the number of the sons of God [that is, Jacob]" (RSV). So the seventy of Israel is God's "portion" (Deuteronomy 32:9) of the seventy nations, and specially set aside for his purpose to bring the truth of his covenant love (Isaiah 42:6) to the world. As Isaiah 49:6 (RSV) puts it, "I will give you as a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth." When Jesus sends out these new elders of Israel, he is telling his people that the kingdom, now "at hand," will reach to the nations!

WHAT IS THE NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL?

The National Eucharistic Revival is a three-year initiative sponsored by the Bishops of the United States to inspire and prepare the People of God to be formed, healed, converted, united, and sent out to a hurting and hungry world through a renewed encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist – the source and summit of our Catholic faith. The Revival officially began in June 2022, and its milestone event will be a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, IN, from July 17-21, 2024. The National Eucharistic Revival and National Eucharistic Congress are a direct response to the Holy Father's call for a "pastoral and missionary conversion which cannot leave things as they presently are" so that the Church in the United States might be "permanently in a state of mission" (Evangelii Gaudium, n. 25).

Year One (2022-2023): Year of Diocesan Revival.

This eucharistic movement seeks to bring together clergy, religious, laity, apostolates, movements, and parish and diocesan leaders to spur momentum, collaboration, and lasting impact for the renewal of the Catholic Church in the U.S. over the next three years. Each year will have a strategic focus for formation and missionary discipleship.

During the first year, the U.S. bishops will be inviting their presbyterates, diocesan teams, and parish leaders to a renewed love for Jesus in the Eucharist by hosting and highlighting diocesan-wide events such as eucharistic congresses and days of formation centered on the mystery of the Eucharist in the life of the Church.

Hello Youth & Young Adults of SJV!

Today's second reading comes from the end of the letter from St. Paul to the church in Galatia. In it he writes, "But far be it from me to glory except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world." In this, he is doubling down on what he said multiple times in the letter previously.

First, in verse 2:20 he says "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."

Then he says in 5:24, "Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires."

As you can see, there is this very clear recurring theme that St. Paul is trying to get the Galatians to understand and live out: once you have given your life to Jesus, you no longer live for yourself, but for Jesus. Your passions, your desires, your wants, your ideas, your intellect and will... all should be directed to the fulfillment of God's will.

This is what it means to be a Christian. It is not a Sunday-only occurrence; it is a moment-to-moment choice to live a life completely and wholly dedicated to God.

Today, and every day, choose to live for Christ.

CATHOLIC MARRIAGE IS A GIFT, NOT A FORMALITY, POPE FRANCIS SAYS AT WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES 2022 OPENING

Pope Francis said Wednesday that Catholic marriage is a gift, not just a formality or rule.

"Marriage is not a formality to be fulfilled. You don't get married to be Catholic 'with the label,' to obey a rule, or because the Church says so, or to throw a party," the pope said at the opening event of the World Meeting of Families on June 22.

"You get married," he continued, "because you want to base your marriage on the love of Christ, which is as firm as a rock."

"We can say that when a man and a woman fall in love, God offers them a gift: marriage. A wonderful gift, which has in it the power of divine love: strong, enduring, faithful, able to recover after any failure or fragility," Francis said.

The 10th edition of the World Meeting of Families, which ends on June 26, includes three days of talks from lay Catholics on subjects related to marriage and the family. Mass and Eucharistic adoration are also on the schedule.

Pope Francis told families: "In marriage Christ gives himself to you, so that you have the strength to give yourselves to each other."

"Take courage, then, family life is not an impossible mission," he added. "With the grace of the sacrament, God makes it a wonderful journey to be taken together with him, never alone."

"Family is not a beautiful ideal, unattainable in reality. God guarantees his presence in marriage and family, not only on your wedding day but throughout your life. And he sustains you every day in your journey," Francis said.


