Video overview: In the Gospel reading, Jesus tells a parable about a rich man who feasted every single day and Lazarus, a beggar, who lies outside the gate of the rich man's house. In the story, both men die and end up in very different places. The poor man ends up in the bosom of Abraham, and the rich man ends up in Hades. Now in Hades, the rich man wants the poor man to serve him, but Abraham says that isn't possible. Nor is it possible for Lazarus to go back to earth and warn the rich man's relatives. No, once we die, we are held accountable for what we did... and what we didn't do. In this parable, it's what the rich man didn't do that has created his misery. The failure to do the good we should have done is called the sin of omission, and that's where the guilt of the rich man rests. He never saw Lazarus as another human being so he did nothing to alleviate his suffering. He might not have actually added to Lazarus' pain, but he failed to help him. We all have people who are lying at the gate of our lives. Instead of stepping over them like the rich man did to Lazarus, we are called to use our resources, whatever they may be, to serve the poor in our lives lest we, too, be guilty of the sin of omission. In addition, the second reading this week, although it does not directly talk about material wealth, does instruct us in how to be rich in character and how to live in imitation of Christ. Both readings remind us that regardless of our own personal financial situation, we can all increase our faith in abundance by serving the poor we encounter in our daily lives.

Featured study: The Good Samaritan

Reflection: It's this reference to Abraham's bosom, traditionally understood as the place where the souls of the just awaited their redemption prior to Christ's coming (CCC 633), which would have appealed to the Pharisees. Jesus may be issuing a warning to the Pharisees as well. Dives did nothing to offend Lazarus, he simply failed to notice him; his heart had grown hard to the point that he couldn't see the needs of a man sitting at his own gate. There's a religious corollary to the hardness of the heart that material wealth can cause. We can easily become complacent toward those who are outside the Church because of the wealth that God has given us in all the graces of the new covenant. We must strive to be more attentive to the needs of those at our gates, even those outside our covenant family. In the case of both material help and sharing the Gospel, fidelity to God and his covenant demands it.





Pope Francis beatifies John Paul I, pope for 33 days

Pope Francis beatified John Paul I, who reigned as pope for only 33 days, amid a thunderstorm in St. Peter's Square on Sunday.

In his homily for the rainy beatification Mass on Sept. 4, Pope Francis said that John Paul I "embodied the poverty of a disciple" through his "victory over the temptation to put oneself at the center, to seek one's own glory."

Often called "the smiling pope," John Paul I died unexpectedly on Sept. 28, 1978, a month after the conclave that elected him.

In one of the shortest pontificates in papal history, John Paul I gained a reputation for his humility and his dedication to teaching the faith in an understandable manner

Cardinals stood in the rain under yellow and white umbrellas as Pope Francis read out the declaration that Pope John Paul I can now be venerated locally on his feast day on Aug. 26.

"With a smile, Pope John Paul I managed to communicate the goodness of the Lord," Francis said.

"How beautiful is a Church with a happy, serene and smiling face, that never closes doors, never hardens hearts, never complains or harbors resentment, does not grow angry or impatient, does not look dour or suffer nostalgia for the past. Let us pray to him, our father and our brother, and ask him to obtain for us 'the smile of the soul."

John Paul I presided over only four general audiences as pope, offering catechesis on poverty, faith, hope, and charity. Pope Francis quoted these catecheses throughout his homily.

"As Pope John Paul I said, if you want to kiss Jesus crucified, 'you cannot help bending over the cross and letting yourself be pricked by a few thorns of the crown on the Lord's head' (General Audience, 27 September 1978). A love that perseveres to the end, thorns and all: no leaving things half done, no cutting corners, no fleeing difficulties," Pope Francis said.

John Paul I was the first pope to be born in the 20th century and the most recent pope to be born in Italy. Born Albino Luciani on Oct. 17, 1912, the future John Paul I grew up in relative poverty in Italy's northern Veneto region.




