# FORMED

### June 9, 2024, TENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME -- Formed.org

**Review:** Today's Gospel demands our conversion, which is a two-step process. It requires a change of heart and then a turning around toward God. It is both an interior and exterior change, which could be likened to re-aligning yourself to follow your north-facing compass-it first requires a knowledge that you are no longer headed north, and then the willingness to change paths in order to head north. Because conversion requires a metanoia or a change of heart, we know that to be converted, our consciences must be open. Truth must be able to penetrate our thoughts so that we become aware of our failings and shortcomings. When our conscience speaks, we need to conform ourselves to the truth instead of trying to justify our wrongdoing. The will then follows the intellect. If we know something to be true and want to embrace that truth, then our actions will begin to follow. The second step in conversion requires us not just turning away from something but turning toward something else. Conversion is turning away from sin and turning toward God; turning away from vice and toward virtue. The best confessors will not just tell us we need to stop being greedy, but rather will encourage us to break the vice of greed by growing in the virtue of generosity.

#### Featured study: Eternal Rest, the art of dying well. 4 part mini-series that is a must watch

**Reflection:** Jesus is accused of insanity by his family and of Satanism by the scribes, learned men from Jerusalem. He seems untroubled by the first accusation, but vehemently rejects the second. Of course, Jesus is not insane, but perhaps he is willing to concede a certain craziness in his activity to the eyes of the world. And as the final verses of today's Gospel show, he is preaching a family bond that goes beyond the bounds of human comprehension. However, Jesus is determined to establish the difference between his work and that of the evil one. First, he summons the scribes. (How interesting that they come and obey his call, even though they seem to have dismissed him. Christ's power is at work.) Then he gives them a parable in the form of three questions about how an interiorly divided entity can survive. Then he asks how one can actually penetrate the defenses and cause such division: How can one bind the strong man? After these compelling arguments, he warns them that they are heading into blasphemy of the worst kind. The sin against the Holy Spirit is unforgivable because it rejects mercy. The scribes have attributed Jesus's merciful restoration to the power of darkness. They are like the older brother in the parable of the Prodigal Son; they see the kindness of the Father as an attack on themselves; and they cannot go to the feast of mercy simply because they won't.

"Let the children come to Me and do not hinder them; for to such belongs the Kingdom of Heaven," said Jesus, The Good Shepherd. To enroll a child in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd you need: 1. Call requesting an interview for your child by phone or by e-mail. 2. Child's Birth Certificate 3. Child's Baptism Certificate if your child has been baptized.



Interviews are done by appointment on Thursdays between the hours of 3:00PM to 6:00PM. Interviews are located at the Saint John Vianney Atrium, located at the end of the school parking lot, last room on the left. Parking is also available in the same area. A Registration package will be given to you after the interview to complete and send back to the office.

## **OCIA Adult Faith Formation**

Adult faith formation, OCIA, is calling for Catechumens, Candidates, and the Curious Catholic.

#### Who are these?

Catechumens are unbaptized persons who desire to become Catholic and join our parish through the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, First Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation. Often, they are learning for the first time many of the elements of the Christian faith. Candidates, on the other hand, are those who are already Christians by baptism and are seeking full communion with the Catholic Church. This includes Catholics who have been baptized but have not had the other Sacraments of Initiation, namely First Holy Eucharist and Confirmation; as well as Christians of other denominations who have had a valid baptism. Curious Catholics are all of us to one extent or another who wish to nurture and nourish our faith through improved understanding of all our Faith has to offer us drawing us closer to Jesus. The OCIA sessions are ideal for that. We will be meeting at 8 am every Sunday morning. Our first meeting will be on the 27th of August.

Please identify those you encounter in your daily life who are seeking or curious about your faith and invite them to explore our Faith further. You can only know by reaching out and asking. While you are at it ask yourself; are you a Curious Catholic? Please have those who are interested call our parish office. Call and leave your name too.

By Courtney Mares, May 23, 2024 Carlo Acutis to be first millennial saint: Pope Francis recognizes miracle for canonization

Pope Francis has recognized a miracle attributed to the intercession of Blessed Carlo Acutis, paving the way for him to become the first millennial saint.

The Italian computer-coding teenager who died of cancer in 2006 is known for his great

devotion to the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The recognition of the second miracle attributed to Acutis' intercession makes it possible that Acutis could be canonized during the Catholic Church's 2025 Jubilee Year.

In a decree on May 23, Pope Francis approved the miraculous healing of a 21-year-old girl from Costa Rica named Valeria Valverde who was near death after seriously injuring her head in a bicycle accident while studying in Florence in 2022.

...Born in 1991, Acutis is the first millennial to be beatified by the Catholic Church. Shortly after his first Communion at the age of 7, Carlo told his mother: "To always be united to Jesus: This is my life plan." To accomplish this, Carlo sought to attend daily Mass as often as possible at the parish church across the street from his elementary school in Milan.

Carlo called the Eucharist "my highway to heaven," and he did all in his power to make this presence known..."May the Lord continue his work through the witness of Blessed Carlo. May he obtain for us from the Lord the grace to love him as he loved him, especially in the holy Eucharist."
