

Review: The more we come to know God through study and prayer, the more we realize his thoughts are not our thoughts, nor are our ways his ways (see Isaiah 55). What we assume God would do is so often challenged by how the events of our lives actually unfold. Today's readings draw us into this mystery of God's complete otherness. In Jesus's time the Jewish people were awaiting the Messiah, or Anointed One, who would liberate them from the captivity of the Romans. They were looking for a military warrior who could defeat the enemy by strength of arm and raise up the Israelites to fight alongside him. But God's ways are not our ways. Jesus came and wasn't a military leader, but rather a teacher, healer, and friend. He consistently allowed people to walk away from him when his teachings were too hard. Jesus wasn't concerned with numbers—he chose only twelve men, not an army. And starting with a kingdom the size of a mustard seed, the Church has grown all over the world.

Featured study: FORMED for Mission Episode 5: The Mystery of the Mustard Seed

Reflection: The mystery of the mustard seed should make us pause and reflect. Our fallen human instinct is to go for strength and size. To do a good job, we think that we must reach as many people as possible, or to be perfect in everything we do. Neither of these follows God's logic. He asks that we rely totally on him, instead of our own strength. This can be called the grace of childlikeness, which it is rooted in the virtue of humility. Childlikeness enables us to surrender ourselves completely to the Lord as his child infinitely loved by him. The smaller and more childlike we become, the more God's strength shines through, just like the mustard seed that grows into the mightiest tree. In what ways do you see yourself tending to think more about your own strength, successes, or perfection, as opposed to being God's child and embracing with your littleness?





By Devin Watkins, June 2, 2024 Pope at Angelus: Eucharist makes us prophets of a new world

Pope Francis prayed the Angelus on Sunday, as the Church in many countries celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, known as Corpus Christi. Ahead of the traditional Marian prayer, the Pope reflected on Jesus' act of giving Himself to us in the Eucharist on the night of the Last Supper.

The Gospel emphasizes the dimension of "gift," he said, noting that Jesus revealed His identity and mission in this simple act of giving bread to His disciples.

"He did not hold back His life for Himself, but gave it to us," said Pope Francis. "He did not consider His being like God a jealous treasure, but stripped Himself of His glory to share our humanity and bring us into eternal life."

Jesus, added the Pope, made his entire life a gift on our behalf.

He went on to note that the Eucharist is a core part of the Christian life of faith.

"Celebrating the Eucharist and feeding on this Bread," he said, "as we do especially on Sundays, is not an act of worship detached from life or a simple moment of personal

Communion, said the Pope, makes each of us capable of offering our own lives for others, since it teaches us to share what we are and what we have.


