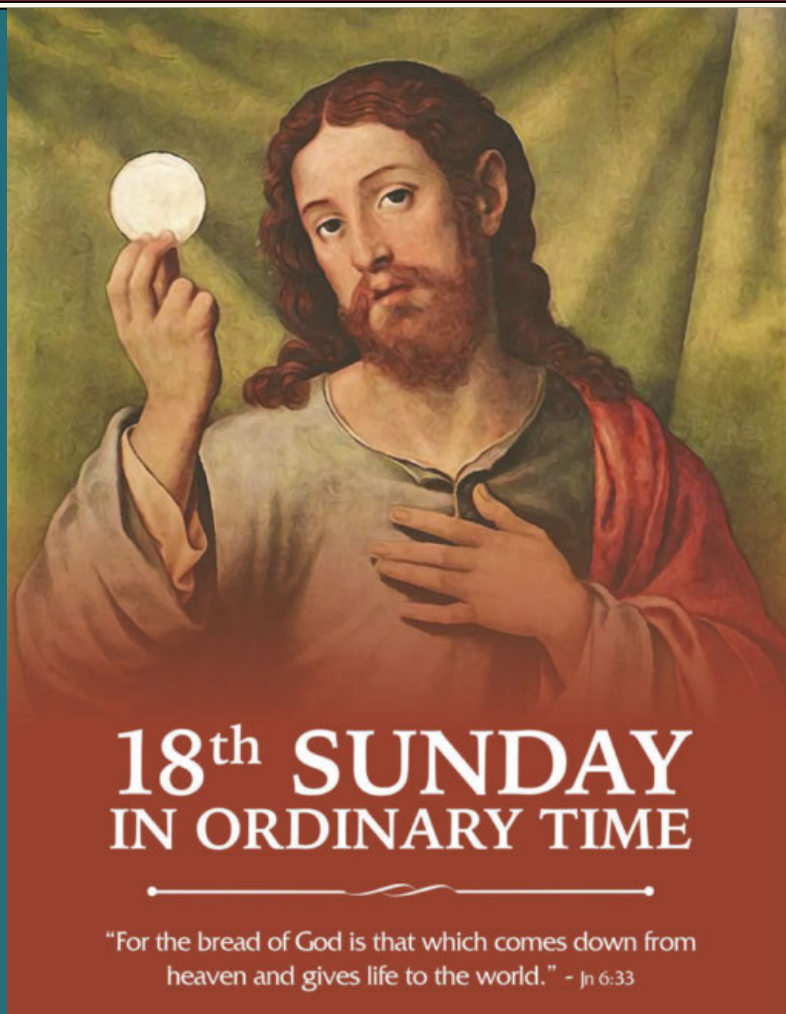

# Word of Life

## 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Thanksgiving and Offering

*“Jesus answered them and said, ‘Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life.’” (John 6: 26-27)*

If last week’s Gospel invited us to consider the reasons why we were approaching Christ. This new “Word of Life” invites us to continue deepening our relationship with Christ by adding one more teaching: follow Him for spiritual reasons, for holiness and not just for material reasons. It is Jesus Himself who shows His disappointment in this Sunday’s Gospel. He knows that many of His admirers follow Him only for material interests. He asks them, “Why are you looking for me?”

Jesus asks us that same question. We have already seen that we should be willing to follow Him not out of self-interest but out of gratitude, out of love and to return to Him some of the many gifts we have received from Him. So, to Christ’s question, we should answer: “Lord, we are looking for You because we want to enjoy Your company, because we want to hear Your message, because without You we cannot and do not want to live. We seek You because we love You. We also seek You because we want the greatest gift from You: Your help in becoming saints. We also seek You because we need Your help solving the problems that make us suffer. We need your strength to carry our cross every day.” Therefore, let’s ask for holiness. Let’s earnestly seek holiness with at least the same determination that we seek health or a good job. Let’s also go to Him to offer ourselves and to tell Him that He can rely on us.

**Resolution:** Each time you address God or Our Lady asking for a favor, examine whether you have first thanked them, offered yourself to help them or asked them for holiness.



## From the Pastor

My Dear Parishioners,

The Church is Mother and Teacher. On the one hand she conceives and raises us as children of God through the Sacraments, and on the other hand, she illumines us through the Word of God that has been transmitted by the Apostles and the Bishops both orally and by writing,

It is one my main tasks as your Pastor to help you form your consciences in the light of the Teachings of the Church. This is why -following the guidelines given by our Bishop Jaime Soto-, I want to provide you with some resources for the upcoming Presidential Election. The material that I will share can be found in the document called Forming Conscience for Faithful Citizenship.

“... Our national tradition of religious freedom permits and encourages all people of faith to bring the insights of their religious traditions to bear on political matters...”

... The sanctity of human life, the equal dignity of all individuals, the obligation to protect the vulnerable, the nature and purposes of sex, marriage, and family—these are not exclusively “religious” truths, but truths that all people of goodwill can come to know without the aid of revelation. Our Catholic faith sheds light on these truths, and so we have a duty to bring that light to our nation.

... While many laity are involved in roles of leadership and service within the Church, it remains primarily the role of the laity to advocate for justice, to serve in public office, and to inform daily life with the gospel...

... While bishops together with their coworkers help form the laity in accordance with basic principles, they do not tell the laity to vote for particular candidates. On these often complex matters, it is the laity’s responsibility to form their consciences and grow in the virtue of prudence to approach the many and varied issues of the day with the mind of Christ. Conscience is “a judgment of reason” by which one determines whether an action is right or wrong (see Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1778). It does not allow us to justify doing whatever we want, nor is it a mere “feeling.” Conscience—properly formed according to God’s revelation and the teaching of the Church—is a means by which one listens to God and discerns how to act in accordance with the truth. The truth is something we receive, not something we make. We can only judge using the conscience we have, but our judgments do not make things true.

...By forming our consciences for faithful citizenship, we can better pursue the common good and thus obey the command of our Lord to love our neighbors.”

## Palabras Del Pastor

Mis Queridos Feligreses,

La Iglesia es Madre y Maestra. Por un lado, nos concibe y educa como hijos de Dios a través de los Sacramentos y, por otro, nos ilumina a través de la Palabra de Dios transmitida por los Apóstoles y los Obispos tanto oralmente como por escrito.

Es una de mis principales tareas como vuestro Pastor ayudarles a formar sus consciencias a la luz de las enseñanzas de la Iglesia. Es por eso por lo que -siguiendo las directrices de nuestro Obispo Jaime Soto-, quiero proporcionarles algunos recursos para las próximas Elecciones Presidenciales. El material que compartiré se encuentra en el documento denominado Formando la conciencia para ser ciudadanos fieles.

“Nuestra tradición nacional de libertad religiosa permite y alienta a todas las personas de fe a aplicar las ideas de sus tradiciones religiosas en cuestiones políticas...”

... La naturaleza sagrada de la vida humana, la igual dignidad de todos los individuos, la obligación de proteger a los vulnerables, la naturaleza y los propósitos del sexo, el matrimonio y la familia, no son verdades exclusivamente “religiosas”, sino verdades que todas las personas de buena voluntad pueden llegar a conocer sin la ayuda de la revelación. Nuestra fe católica ilumina estas verdades y por eso tenemos el deber de llevar esa luz a nuestra nación.

... Si bien muchos laicos participan en roles de liderazgo y servicio dentro de la Iglesia, el papel principal de los laicos sigue siendo abogar por la justicia, servir en cargos públicos e informar la vida diaria con el evangelio.

... Si bien los obispos, junto con sus compañeros de trabajo, ayudan a formar a los laicos de acuerdo con principios básicos, no les dicen que voten por ciertos candidatos en particular. En estos asuntos, a menudo complejos, es responsabilidad de los laicos formar su conciencia y crecer en la virtud de la prudencia para considerar las muchas y variadas cuestiones del día con el modo de pensar de Cristo.

La conciencia es “un juicio de la razón” mediante el cual uno determina si una acción es correcta o incorrecta (consulten el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, n. 1778). No nos permite justificar hacer lo que queramos, ni es un mero “sentimiento”. La conciencia, debidamente formada según la revelación de Dios y las enseñanzas de la Iglesia, es un medio por el cual se escucha a Dios y se discierne cómo actuar de acuerdo con la verdad. La verdad es algo que recibimos, no algo que hacemos. Sólo podemos juzgar usando la conciencia que tenemos, pero nuestros juicios no hacen que las cosas sean verdaderas.

... Al formar nuestra conciencia para ser ciudadanos fieles, podemos buscar mejor el bien común y así obedecer el mandato de nuestro Señor de amar a nuestro prójimo.”

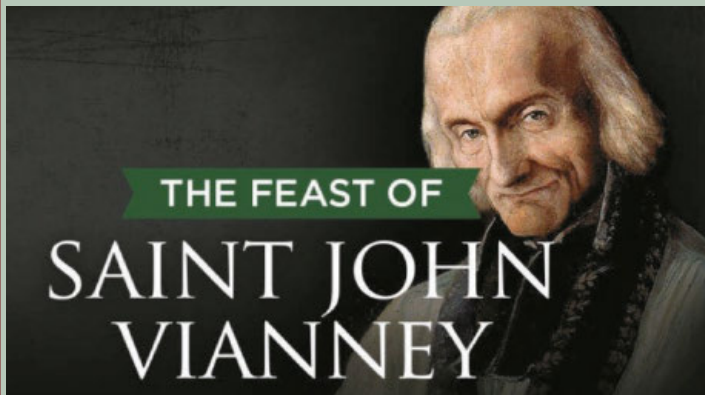

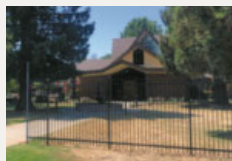

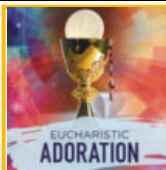

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held once a month on Sunday from 11:30am-2:30pm.

## Bautizos:

## Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

## Matrimonio:

## First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

## Primera Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

## Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

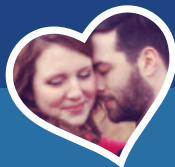

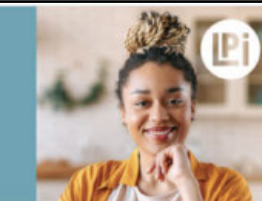
