Word of Life

19th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Don't Criticize

It's really hard not to criticize. In one way or another, most of us do it, although most of the time that criticism is mild and based on truthful arguments. Certainly, truly harmful criticisms should be distinguished from those that are simple comments made with a little lightness but without malice. But, even these "light" comments hurt, especially when we learn that others have made them about us. Therefore, we should assume that we also hurt others when we make them.

Moreover, to criticize is to attribute to oneself the functions of a judge, to consider oneself superior to the ones criticized and to usurp a power that only God, who knows everything, is capable of holding and executing. Only the Lord is judge of consciences and no one can purport to usurp that position.

That is why Jesus teaches us not to criticize but to give others a second chance, even to the point of making excuses to justify the behavior of another if warranted. If we can honestly tell the Father that we have tried to be understanding with our neighbors, only then can we ask Him to be understanding with us. Finally, it would be good to apply the advice of St. Francis of Assisi when he asked that nothing be said about anyone absent that could not be said to his face with love.

Resolution: When you feel tempted to criticize someone, think if you would like them to say the same about you behind your back. Remember that the measure you use with others will be used by others with you.



From the Pastor

My dear parishioners,

We continue the catechesis on the formation of conscience in order to help you get the Christian criteria to carry out your right and duty to vote, and so promote the establishment of God's Kingdom of life and justice.

Voting is not an easy task; it requires much reflection and above all much prayer. So, I encourage you to meditate not only upon these little excerpts of *Forming Conscience for Faithful Citizenship*, but to accompany your reflection with prayer, thus opening your hearts to God's action in you.

"Every human being has the right to live with dignity and to develop integrally; this fundamental right cannot be denied by any country. People have this right even if they are unproductive, or were born with or developed limitations. This does not detract from their great dignity as human persons, a dignity based not on circumstances but on the intrinsic worth of their being.... (Pope Francis, Fratelli Tutti, no. 107)"

"We work to protect the most vulnerable—children in the womb who are in danger of abortion—while also standing in radical solidarity with mothers...."

"We continue to protect the dignity of our sister or brother who is elderly, disabled, or ill by strongly rejecting euthanasia and assisted suicide...."

"Likewise, we must recognize the inherent dignity of the migrant and refugee...."

"We support the dignity of the person, created male or female; therefore, we oppose a gender ideology that fails to recognize the difference and reciprocity between man and woman."

"...We must overcome racism in our hearts as well as in our systems and institutions."

"We continue to seek reform of the criminal justice system and to end the use of the death penalty...."

"...we seek to prevent and remedy any aspects of an "economy of exclusion," which "does not hesitate to exploit, discard, and even kill human beings," and to work instead toward an "economy of communion" rooted in ethical concern."

"... Debemos superar el racismo tanto en nuestros corazones como en nuestros sistemas e instituciones."

"... Buscamos prevenir y remediar cualquier aspecto de una "economía de la exclusión"⁸ que "no duda en explotar, descartar e incluso matar al hombre"⁹, y trabajamos en cambio hacia una "economía de la comunión" arraigada en una preocupación ética."

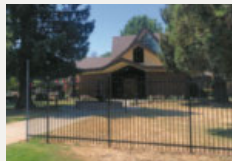

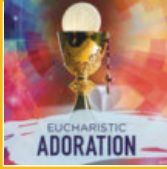

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held once a month on Sunday from 11:30am-2:30pm.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

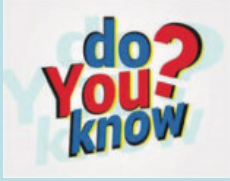

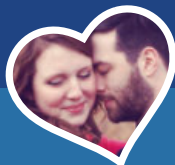
