# Word of Life

## 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time: Heart by Heart

*"He responded, 'Well did Isaiah prophesy about you hypocrites, as it is written: 'This people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines human precepts.'" (Mark 7: 6-7)*

Continuing with last week's theme, this Sunday's Gospel by a different evangelist shows us Jesus' disappointment at the response of His people, His beloved people, His chosen people that He had come to save. "This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me," the Master even said, echoing an ancient prophecy.

What about us? Could we also say that? Certainly, we honor Him with our lips, which is not bad in and of itself, and it is becoming increasingly necessary to do so in order to give public witness to our faith. But it should also be true that, while doing so, we try to do it with our hearts. That is what this week is about: deepening our cordial, emotional and loving relationship with Christ. It will be about telling Him, by our prayers and good works, that we love Him, that He is Number One in our lives and that, for Him and with Him, we are willing to do whatever He asks of us. It is a week to exercise "For You, Jesus" in everything we do so that the Lord is convinced that, although we are sinners and sometimes fail, He can count on our hearts. Modifying Quevedo's poetry a bit, we should say to the Lord, both with works and words, "Dust I am, more dust in love" or "I am a sinner, but I love you. I love You, Lord, because You deserve it, because with Your mercy You have conquered my heart. And my chief sorrow is not loving You more, not loving You enough, not always being faithful to You so that You can be proud of me for my entire life."

**Resolution:** As often as possible when you are doing something, tell the Lord, "For You, Jesus." Consciously, show your love for Him by taking on difficult and thankless tasks.



## From the Pastor

My dear parishioners,

I want to wrap up the catechesis on forming the conscience for living the Gospel in the public sphere by quoting the Bishops' address to all "voters and candidates, citizens and elected officials."

"... In light of ethical principles, we bishops offer the following policy goals that we hope will guide Catholics as they form their consciences and reflect on the moral dimensions of their public choices. Not all issues are equal; these ten goals address matters of different moral weight and urgency.... We hope Catholics will ask candidates how they intend to help our nation pursue these important goals:"

"Address the preeminent requirement to protect the weakest in our midst—innocent unborn children—by restricting and bringing to an end the destruction of unborn children through abortion and providing women in crisis pregnancies the supports they need to make a decision for life."

"Keep our nation from turning to violence to address fundamental problems—a million abortions each year to deal with unwanted pregnancies, euthanasia and assisted suicide to deal with the burdens of illness and disability, the destruction of human embryos in the name of research, the use of the death penalty to combat crime, and imprudent resort to war to address international disputes."

"Protect the fundamental understanding of marriage as the lifelong and faithful union of one man and one woman and as the central institution of society; promote the complementarity of the sexes and reject false "gender" ideologies..."

"Achieve comprehensive immigration reform that offers a path to citizenship, treats immigrant workers fairly, prevents the separation of families, maintains the integrity of our borders, respects the rule of law, and addresses the factors that compel people to leave their own countries."

"Help families and children overcome poverty: ensuring access to and choice in education, as well as decent work at fair, living wages and adequate assistance for the vulnerable in our nation..."

"Provide health care while respecting human life, human dignity, and religious freedom in our health care system."

"Continue to oppose policies that reflect prejudice, hostility toward immigrants, religious bigotry, and other forms of unjust discrimination."

"Encourage families, community groups, economic structures, and government to work together to overcome poverty, pursue the common good, and care for creation..."

"Establish and comply with moral limits on the use of military force... with a special view to seeking a responsible and effective response for ending the persecution of Christians and other religious minorities in the Middle East and other parts of the world."

"Join with others around the world to pursue peace..."

## Palabras Del Pastor

Mis queridos feligreses,

Quiero terminar la catechesis sobre la formación de la conciencia para vivir el Evangelio en la esfera pública citando el discurso de los Obispos a todos "los votantes y a los candidatos, a los ciudadanos y a los funcionarios públicos".

"... A la luz de los principios éticos, nosotros, los obispos, ofrecemos los siguientes objetivos políticos que esperamos guiarán a los católicos a medida que estos formen su conciencia y reflexionen sobre las dimensiones morales de las opciones públicas que tienen. No todas las cuestiones pesan igual; estos diez objetivos tratan cuestiones de diferente peso y urgencia moral... Esperamos que los católicos pregunten a los candidatos cómo estos piensan ayudar a nuestra nación a conseguir estos objetivos importantes:"

"Tratar el requisito supremo de proteger a los más débiles de entre nosotros —los niños inocentes no nacidos— restringiendo y poniendo fin a la destrucción de los niños no nacidos mediante el aborto provocado y proporcionando a las mujeres en crisis de embarazo los apoyos que necesitan para tomar una decisión a favor de la vida."

"Proteger el concepto fundamental del matrimonio como la unión fiel y para toda la vida de un hombre y una mujer y como la institución central de la sociedad; promover la complementariedad de los sexos y rechazar las falsas ideologías de "género"..."

"Conseguir una reforma migratoria comprensiva que ofrezca un camino a la ciudadanía, trate a los trabajadores inmigrantes con justicia, impida la separación de las familias, mantenga la integridad de nuestras fronteras, respete el estado de derecho y se preocupe por los factores que fuerzan a las personas a abandonar sus países de origen."

"Ayudar a las familias y a los niños a salir de la pobreza, asegurando el acceso y opciones a la educación, así como un puesto de trabajo justo con salarios que permitan vivir, y asistencia adecuada para los más vulnerables de nuestra nación..."

"Proveer cuidado médico a la vez que se respeta la vida humana, la dignidad humana y la libertad religiosa en nuestro sistema de salud."

"Continuar oponiéndose a políticas que reflejan prejuicios, hostilidad hacia los inmigrantes, intolerancia religiosa y otras formas de discriminación injusta."

"Animar a las familias, grupos comunitarios, estructuras económicas y gobiernos a trabajar juntos para erradicar la pobreza, buscar el bien común y cuidar la creación..."

"Establecer y cumplir con los límites morales concernientes al uso de la fuerza militar..., con miras especialmente a buscar una respuesta responsable y eficaz para poner fin a la persecución de los cristianos y otras minorías religiosas en el Medio Oriente y otras partes del mundo."

"Unirse a otras naciones del mundo para buscar la Paz..."

## FIRST ATRIUM SESSION



This coming Thursday our children will be back from vacation. September 5, 2024 is the first session of the new Atrium Year of 2024-2025. We welcome back our second and third year children and are very excited to start working with our new first year children. In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd a child spends 3 years in level one. The first session of the year is a one hour session. In this session our new children are introduced to the Atrium and to our most important book, the Holy Bible, that is in the Prayer Corner. New Children learn from returning children how to set up the Prayer Table. Together, new and returning children, pot a plant to make the Atrium more beautiful and they learn how to take care of this new plant. In every session a different child takes care of the plant so as to learn how to take care of the environment around us. ## Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held once a month on Sunday from 11:30am-2:30pm.

## Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

## Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

## Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

## First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

## Primera Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

## Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

## Confirmación para Jóvenes:

Candidatos para Confirmación deben de tener los 12 años cumplidos y cursar el séptimo grado. El programa es de dos años de educación religiosa antes de recibir el Sacramento.

## OCIA and Adult Sacramental:

For adults seeking one or more Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Eucharist, or Confirmation). Sessions begin in the fall. Please contact the parish office for more information.
