

# Word of Life

#### 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Be Merciful and Embrace the Sinner

"John said to him, 'Teacher, we saw someone driving out demons in your name, and we tried to prevent him because he does not follow us.' Jesus replied, 'Do not prevent him. There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us.'" (Mk 9: 38-40)

It This week's "word of life" invites us to practice that fashionable virtue of "tolerance", but understood in a Christian way. Jesus tells his disciples that everyone fits in the Church because everyone fits in the loving heart of the Father. Everyone, including the most notorious sinners. This has to lead us to an attitude of welcome and not of rejection, of understanding others and even their weaknesses and sins.

However, this understanding does not mean that we have to agree with those who do not practice tolerance, that we have to say that evil does not exist or that, given our understanding of the sinner, we must tell him that what he does is of no importance and that he may continue to sin. This is where we differ from the secularized way of living tolerance. Christ, who is always our model, ate with the public sinners of his time - publicans and prostitutes - and did not hesitate to confront a hypocritically puritan society to defend an adulteress who was going to be stoned.

However, he told the publicans to stop stealing, the prostitutes to earn an honest living, and the adulteress not to sin anymore. Let's be uncompromising with sin but welcoming and merciful to the sinner. In order to receive the Father's embrace, it is enough for him to repent and to want to change. Let's not forget, everyone has a place in the Church as long as they want to be holy, even if as of yet they are not. Thanks to that, we ourselves may also fit in.

**<u>Resolution</u>**: Practice mercy along with a good understanding of tolerance, which consists of accepting the legitimate differences that others have from you. Don't accept the sin but embrace the sinner.

My dear parishioners,



#### YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese. Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.
