Word of Life

28th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Avoid Sins of Omission

"You are lacking in one thing. Go, sell what you have, and give to [the] poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." At that statement his face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions. Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!" (Mark 10: 21-23)

The story of the rich young man has sometimes been interpreted as the expression of the two paths that would exist in the Christian life: that of the lay person who seeks salvation by fulfilling the minimum, that is, by observing the commandments; and that of those who aspire to something more, to religious or priestly consecration, which requires a more radical following of Christ.

I do not think that this interpretation is correct, because the same precepts apply to all Christians: the commandments on the one hand and the law of love on the other. It is not true that the path of the laity is that of just getting by with the minimum and that of going above and beyond is that of the religious or priest. We are all called to the same vocation, that of holiness. We will reach it when we observe the commandments -the minimum- and when we try to practice charity -the maximum. Charity, love, is for everyone and not just for a select few who, perhaps one day, we will venerate on altars. The precept is to love one's enemies, to give alms to those in need, to console the suffering, to clothe the naked, to accompany the lonely, to fulfill one's obligations, and to carry on our own backs some of the weight of others so that others can see their burden relieved. There is not a second-rate path and a first-rate path. There is only one Christian path: that of love for God and neighbor.

Resolution: Every day, ask the Lord in prayer: What can I do for you? What can I do for my neighbor? Examine your conscience for any sins of omission.

Next year... more! More spirituality, more bonds of unity and love between us! And why not? More prizes!!! Who would complain about going on vacation to Hawaii or getting a new car...? Just thinking out loud...

Thank you all for your support, thank you for your enthusiasm, for your commitment and love for God and your Parish and SJV School. I hope this yields the fruit of more conversions to Christ, the Savior.

Catechesis of the Good

THE MODEL ALTAR

In the introduction to life in the Church, we learn about the model altar that has the basic articles used in the Mass. The Holy Mass is Jesus' most holy meal. In the Eucharistic celebration of the Mass, the priest uses the most important articles: The white altar cloth, the chalice, the paten, the crucifix and two bees wax candles that make the altar most beautiful. In the Atrium after we are done setting up the model altar, the candles are lighted, and silently we just watch the altar in contemplation. It's like a little prayer at the altar. At Mass the altar is complete and it's the most beautiful it can be because Jesus' own body and blood are present. The Eucharistic Celebration is the most treasured gift given to us by God. Let's come to Mass and take part in Jesus' holy meal! Come to the table of plenty!
