

Word of Life

Second Sunday of Advent: Believe in Grace

I have baptized you with water; he will baptize you with the holy Spirit. (Mk 1: 8)

In this week's Gospel, we are invited to do something that is especially difficult today: have faith in God's grace, faith that God has not left us alone in our daily fight against sin, and faith that God's strength is capable of intervening in our life so that we may overcome temptation. Because we want to believe in grace, we will have to be fearless at times, even taking initiatives that can be risky. At other times, this faith in grace will make us be patient because we believe that if something is happening then it is because God, albeit mysteriously, allows it. Finally, believing in grace will help us to practice the sacraments, especially confession, a beautiful act of faith in which God forgives our sins and helps us not to repeat them.

Let us think of the Virgin Mary, the Most Pure, the one full of grace. Because she believed in the strength of God, she accepted the risks involved in doing God's will. She knew that for men what the Lord proposed to her was impossible, but for God, as the angel told her, the word "impossible" does not exist. During this second week of Advent, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. Let us take the opportunity to set our sights on Mary in a special, more profound way. From a human standpoint, so much must have seemed impossible to her: the Incarnation... impossible; that her child was God... impossible; that if He was God He would die on the cross... impossible; the Resurrection...impossible. But, she always believed in God, in His strength, in His grace, and because she believed, she hoped, and because she hoped, she was victorious.

Let's do the same. Let's imitate Mary, who is full of grace.

Resolution: "What does God want me to do?" And, barring excessiveness, I will prepare to do God's will, knowing that He can accomplish everything.



From the Pastor | Palabras Del Pastor

My dear parishioners,

We all have a natural longing for prayer, because we are thirsty for God, and consequently we either act on it and we pray, or we try to suffice it by devoting ourselves to other things making them our little gods. This longing is always there, there are no in-betweens. We not only see this longing in the Lord Jesus, who spent hours with His Father in solitude and silence, but at the same time we know He is the only one who can perfectly teach us how and what to pray for, because no one has ever seen God; the only Son, God, who is at the Father's side, has revealed him (Jn 1:18).

As a priest I have met two types of people when it came to prayer. On the one hand those who only ask. These normally forsake God when their problems have been solved, or they even turn their backs on Him, disappointed and angry at Him because their prayers were not heard the way they wanted. Their motivation is selfishness. On the other hand, those who say they never ask for anything, or if they ever do it, it is just to pray for others. They say that they have been so blessed by God that they would not ask for anything, because they believe it would be selfish. These have masked their pride with a false humility. True prayer places us before God as beggars, as dependent on Him, and not wanting to ask for anything is refusing this filial bond with Him. Actually, the Lord urged us to knock and to ask. The balance point is the Lord Jesus Himself who asked His Heavenly Father for others and for himself, and at the same time praised Him in thanksgiving for His goodness and wisdom.

In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus (1 Thess 5:18). We should not just ask in all circumstances, whether things are going well or bad, but also, we should learn to give thanks in the good and the bad. This is the will of God for us. This is what we say in most of the prefaces: "It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God." It is easy to be grateful in good times. But when we really grow in the virtue of gratitude is when we are able to give thanks amidst difficult times. When we do so, we experience peace, joy and love. The grateful person is always able to smile and say "I live in a wonderful world", even when there are no human reasons to say so, because he does not only realize the good things he is learning in his difficulties, but his Heavenly Father's loving Providence. Gratitude in this sense unfolds the Divine Presence and Love laying beneath the horrifying mask of suffering.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in you. Fr. Antonio Gutierrez, FM. Pastor Mis queridos feligreses,

Todos tenemos un anhelo natural de hacer oración porque tenemos sed de Dios, y en consecuencia o rezamos, o tratamos de satisfacerlo dedicándonos a otras cosas convirtiéndolas en nuestros pequeños dioses. Este anhelo siempre está ahí. Lo vemos en el Señor Jesús, que pasaba horas con su Padre en soledad y silencio. Además, sabemos que Él es el único que puede enseñarnos plenamente cómo y por qué rezar, porque a Dios nadie lo ha visto jamás; el Hijo único, Dios, que está junto al Padre, lo ha revelado (Jn 1,18).

Como sacerdote he conocido dos tipos de personas en cuanto a la oración se refiere. Por un lado, los que sólo piden. Estos normalmente abandonan a Dios cuando sus problemas se han resuelto, o incluso le dan la espalda, decepcionados y enfadados con Él porque sus oraciones no han sido escuchadas como ellos querían. Su motivación es el egoísmo. Por otro lado, los que dicen que nunca piden nada, o si alguna vez lo hacen, es sólo para rezar por los demás. Dicen que han sido tan bendecidos por Dios que no pedirían nada, porque creen que sería egoísta. Estos han enmascarado su soberbia con una falsa humildad. La verdadera oración nos sitúa ante Dios como mendigos, como dependientes de Él, y no querer pedir nada es rechazar este vínculo filial con Él. El punto de equilibrio es el ejemplo del Señor Jesús, que pedía a su Padre Celestial por los demás y por sí mismo, y al mismo tiempo le daba gracias por su bondad y sabiduría.

Dad gracias en todo, porque esta es la voluntad de Dios para con vosotros en Cristo Jesús (1 Tes 5,18). No sólo debemos pedir en todo momento, tanto si las cosas van bien como si van mal, sino que también debemos aprender a dar gracias en lo bueno y en lo malo. Esta es la voluntad de Dios para nosotros. Esto es lo que decimos en la mayoría de los prefacios: «Es verdaderamente justo y necesario, nuestro deber y salvación, darte gracias siempre y en todo lugar, Señor, Padre santo, Dios todopoderoso y eterno». Es fácil ser agradecido cuando todo va bien. Pero cuando realmente crecemos en la virtud del agradecimiento es cuando somos capaces de dar gracias en los momentos difíciles. Cuando lo hacemos, experimentamos paz, alegría, amor. La persona agradecida siempre es capaz de sonreír y decir «vivo en un mundo maravilloso», incluso cuando no hay razones humanas para decirlo, porque no sólo se da cuenta del bien que saca de sus dificultades, sino de la Providencia amorosa de su Padre Celestial. El agradecimiento, en este sentido, desvelan la Presencia y el Amor Divinos que yacen bajo la terrible máscara del sufrimiento.




