

Word of Life

The Baptism of the Lord:

"The people were filled with expectation, and all were asking in their hearts whether John might be the Christ. John answered them all, saying, 'I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.'" (Lk 3:15-16)

Even though the experience of today's Christians is that of feeling mocked in the majority of cases, at times one finds different situations. There are people who say they envy our faith because they know that, thanks to it, we have more strength, more fervor, more hope and less solitude. Except for the mystery of faith, which is a gift, we may say to those who question us this way that, in order to find something, they must search for it. One way they can seek it is by practicing it. If practice makes perfect, would not the same thing happen with faith? Is it not true that when we stop practicing, our soul ends up becoming cold, even sometimes losing faith? Then why should not the opposite happen if we do the opposite?

Actually, the worst enemy of faith is not the argument about the existence of evil in the world nor any other philosophical matter. It is not even the fact that faith gives us a very annoying moral conscience. The worst enemy of faith is laziness, complacency. How many Christians are there who say they don't go to Mass because they get bored, while all they have to do is drive a few miles to find a lively parish in which Sundays Masses are not boring! But they still prefer to say Mass is tiresome and use that excuse to stop going to Mass.

Those who seek find. Those who really want to find Christ seek Him, just as the people who were filled with expectation were looking for John because they thought he was the Messiah.

Resolution: Do you dedicate enough time to prayer and religious practices? If you are dispassionate, is it not because you practice your faith so little? Do you bother to educate yourself, to read and to seek the help you need?

From the Pastor

My dear parishioners,

We continue with the catechesis on the sacramentals. They are sacred signs instituted by the Church and they lead us to holy realities which dispose our souls to receive God's grace. We will begin by explaining the sacramental gestures, among which we have the sign of the cross.

The sign of the cross is also known as the "sign of Christ" or "the seal of the living God", and it is the chief sacramental used in the Church. The Lord said *whatever you ask in* my name, I will do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son (Jn 14:13). When we cross ourselves and invoke the name of the triune God we open ourselves to His blessing. Tertullian (AD 155-220) said that "in all our actions, when we come in or go out, when we dress, when we wash, at our meals, before retiring to sleep... we form on our foreheads the sign of the cross. These practices are not commanded by a formal law of scripture; the Tradition teaches them, custom confirms them, faith observes them." It has so many meanings: it's a reminder and re-acceptance of our baptism and a summary of our profession of faith in the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; it calls to mind Christ's Passion and Death and his Sacred wounds when using our five fingers; it affirms the Incarnation as we go from our forehead to beneath the breast with our right hand, and reminds us the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and Son; it "makes all hell tremble" (St. John Vianney), as it is a silent prayer of exorcism and sign of protection. "The cross is the badge that shows who we are: our speaking, thinking, looking, working are under the Sign of the Cross, that is, the love of Jesus, to the end" (Pope Francis). There is a clerical form of the Sign of the Cross only reserved for clergy (Deacons, Priests and Bishops) when performing blessings.

"Be the cross our seal made with boldness by our fingers on our brow, and on everything..." (St. Cyril). Because it is sacred sign, one must do it with utmost reverence, never sloppily and hastily. There is a beautiful custom of making the sign of the cross when passing a Catholic Church (because the Blessed Sacrament is there), or a cemetery, or before a holy image.

May we intend to conform ourselves to the Cross of Christ every time we cross ourselves, that is, to be crucified with Him to the world and live for God alone.

Palabras Del Pastor

Mis queridos feligreses,

Continuamos con la catequesis sobre los sacramentales. Son signos sagrados instituidos por la Iglesia que nos conducen a realidades sagradas que disponen nuestras almas para recibir la gracia de Dios. Comenzaremos explicando los sacramentales gestuales, entre los que encontramos la señal de la cruz.

La señal de la cruz también se conoce como «la señal de Cristo» o «el sello de Dios vivo», y es el principal sacramental utilizado en la Iglesia. El Señor dijo que todo lo que pidáis en mi nombre, yo lo haré, para que el Padre sea glorificado en el Hijo (Jn 14,13). Al invocar el nombre del Dios trino al hacernos la señal de la cruz, nos disponemos a recibir su bendición. Tertuliano (155-220 d.C.) decía que «en todas nuestras acciones, cuando entramos o salimos, cuando nos vestimos, cuando nos lavamos, en nuestras comidas, antes de acostarnos... formamos en nuestra frente la señal de la cruz. Estas prácticas no están ordenadas por una ley formal de la Escritura; pero la Tradición las enseña, la costumbre las confirma, ya la fe las observa.» Tiene tantos significados: es un recordatorio y una reaceptación de nuestro bautismo y un resumen de nuestra profesión de fe en el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo; evoca la Pasión y Muerte de Cristo y sus Sagradas llagas cuando usamos nuestros cinco dedos; afirma la Encarnación al ir desde la frente hasta debajo del pecho con la mano derecha, y nos recuerda que el Espíritu Santo procede del Padre y del Hijo; «hace temblar todo el infierno» (San Juan Vianney), pues es una oración silenciosa de exorcismo y signo de protección. «La cruz es la insignia que muestra quiénes somos: nuestro hablar, pensar, mirar, trabajar están bajo el Signo de la Cruz, es decir, el amor de Jesús, hasta el final» (Papa Francisco). Existe una forma de la Señal de la Cruz sólo reservada sólo a los clérigos (Diáconos, Sacerdotes y Obispos) cuando éstos realizan dan bendiciones.

«Sea la cruz nuestro sello hecho con denuedo por nuestros dedos sobre nuestra frente, y sobre todo…» (San Cirilo). Por tratarse de un signo sagrado, hay que hacerlo con suma reverencia, nunca de forma descuidada y apresurada. Hay una hermosa costumbre de hacerse la señal de la cruz al pasar por una iglesia católica (porque allí está el Santísimo Sacramento), o por un cementerio, o ante una imagen sagrada.

Ojalá nos propongamos conformarnos a la Cruz de Cristo cada vez que nos persignemos, es decir, crucificarnos con Él al mundo y vivir sólo para Dios.
