Word of Life

2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time: Do Whatever He Tells You

"There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servers, 'Do whatever he tells you.'" (John 2:1-11).

At the wedding feast in Cana, many things were brought to light. One of them was that Jesus counted on the support of God, just as His disciples did when they saw the miracle of the transformation of water into wine. Another was His blessing our human love, and with it, instituting the Sacrament of Matrimony.

But that, and much more, could only happen thanks to the presence of the Virgin Mary there. She was the one who urged Jesus to have mercy on the wedding couple, from which it is easy to deduce that she knew her son could perform miracles. And, above all, she was the one who left us one of the most beautiful phrases of the New Testament, which has become an entire life plan: "Do whatever He tells you".

Ever since then, Mary always shows herself to us as the one who permanently directs us to her son urging us to obey Him. She encourages us to do so even if we don't understand, just as what happened to the servants who filled up the jars without knowing the miracle that was going to happen. She asks us to obey, to follow Christ, not only to bring her Son joy, but also because it is best for us. Christ has given us enough reasons to trust in Him, in His word, and in His will. But, if for whatever reason we feel distant from Him, look to Mary: trust her, obey her. She, who has always been beside us, will show us the way: Do whatever He tells you.

Resolution: Do whatever God asks of you - fulfill your duties, the commandments, just as they are taught by the Church- even if you don't understand them and have doubts.



From the Pastor | Palabras Del Pastor

My dear parishioners,

"At the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth." (Philippians 2:10) Genuflection comes from the Latin word genuflectere (genu: "knee"; flectere: "to bend") and is another sacramental gesture. We genuflect by bending our right knee to the ground.

One of the signs of secularism and relativism in the Catholic Church is the lack of reverence toward sacred realities. For instance, Catholics in general no longer know how to behave in the presence of God when they are in the church, where His real presence in the Tabernacle is. The House of God has become not the place for prayer but a place to socialize. Even in our dear Parish temple I see people chatting all over before Mass when it is not really necessary, thus not respecting others to concentrate in their prayer and indirectly contributing to desacralize a holy place. Of course, there are situations where we ought to speak and talk to each other, and prudence and love are our guide in that matter, but exceptions cannot become a norm. The familiarity with God that we His adopted children have is not at odds with respect, due reverence and sacred silence, elements that help our souls enter the holy presence of God.

Genuflection is one of the sacramentals that fosters a deeper awareness of God's presence and the due regard to Him. It is reserved for the Most Blessed Sacrament, as well as for the Holy Cross from the solemn adoration during the liturgical celebration on Good Friday until the beginning of the Easter Vigil (GIRM no. 274). During Mass, we see the Priest genuflecting three times: two during the consecration and one before taking communion. Also, every time he or a deacon approaches the Tabernacle to take or repose the Blessed Sacrament. During the Eucharistic Prayer everybody is kneeling until the Our Father to show adoration to the Blessed Sacrament and to plead for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. When entering and exiting the church, if the Tabernacle is visible, we should genuflect. And every time we cross in front of the Tabernacle we should genuflect. The red candle next to the tabernacle is an indicator that Christ our Lord is there and reminds us to genuflect. Of course, if one has physical issues, a bow would be enough to render homage to Christ in the Eucharist.

I pray that as we genuflect, we may be disposed to receive the inspirations of the Holy Spirit to learn how to mindfully walk in the Presence of the Most High, not only at church, but at every moment.

Mis queridos feligreses,

Al nombre de Jesús toda rodilla se doble en el cielo, en la tierra, en el abismo (Flp 2,10). La genuflexión viene del latín genuflectere (genu: «rodilla»; flectere: «doblar») y es otro gesto sacramental. Hacemos la genuflexión doblando la rodilla derecha hasta tocar el suelo.

Uno de los signos del secularismo y del relativismo en la Iglesia católica es la falta de reverencia hacia las cosas sagradas. Por ejemplo, los católicos en general ya no saben cómo comportarse en presencia de Dios cuando están en la iglesia, donde está su presencia real en el Sagrario. La Casa de Dios se ha convertido no en el lugar de oración sino en un sitio para socializar. Incluso en nuestro querido templo parroquial veo a gente charlando por todas partes antes de Misa cuando no es realmente necesario, no respetando así a los demás para concentrarse en su oración y contribuyendo indirectamente a desacralizar un lugar sagrado. Por supuesto que hay situaciones en las que debemos hablar y conversar, y la prudencia y el amor son nuestra guía en esa materia, pero las excepciones no pueden convertirse en norma. La familiaridad con Dios que tenemos sus hijos adoptivos no está reñida con el respeto y la reverencia debidas, elementos que ayudan a nuestras almas a entrar en Su santa presencia.

La genuflexión es uno de los sacramentales que fomentan una conciencia más profunda de la presencia de Dios. Está reservada al Santísimo Sacramento, así como a la Santa Cruz, desde la adoración solemne durante la celebración litúrgica del Viernes Santo hasta el comienzo de la Vigilia Pascual (IGMR nº 274). Durante la Misa, vemos al sacerdote hacer la genuflexión tres veces: dos durante la consagración y una antes de comulgar. También, cada vez que él o un diácono se acerca al Sagrario para tomar o reposar el Santísimo Sacramento. Durante la Plegaria Eucarística todos están arrodillados hasta el Padrenuestro para mostrar adoración al Santísimo Sacramento y suplicar la efusión del Espíritu Santo. Al entrar y salir de la iglesia, si el Sagrario es visible, debemos hacer una genuflexión. Y cada vez que pasemos delante del Sagrario debemos hacer una genuflexión. La vela roja junto al Sagrario es un indicador de que Cristo Nuestro Señor está allí y nos recuerda que debemos hacer una genuflexión. Por supuesto, si uno tiene problemas físicos, una inclinación sería suficiente para rendir homenaje a Cristo en la Eucaristía.

Rezo para que, al hacer la genuflexión, estemos dispuestos a recibir las inspiraciones del Espíritu Santo para aprender a caminar conscientemente en la Presencia del Altísimo, no sólo en la iglesia, sino en todo momento.
