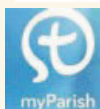

Word of Life

4th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Accept Criticism

“Amen, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own native place....” When the people in the synagogue heard this, they were all filled with fury. They rose up, drove him out of the town, and led him to the brow of the hill on which their town had been built, to hurl him down headlong.” (Luke 4:24; 28-29).

They attempted to kill Jesus, in Nazareth no less. That His own countrymen had killed Him would have been even more tragic than His ultimate death in Jerusalem. Without a doubt, they were about to kill Jesus whom they had played with as a child and who had done many favors for them.

Why?

First, out of envy because someone successful is not forgiven. Second, He did not perform the miracles there that they expected and that, basically, were summed up in only one thing: pouring out health and good fortune on their neighbors. Third, Christ dared to criticize them. We too tend to act like that: envy leads us to despise our neighbor and to feel annoyed with his success and happy with his failure. Furthermore, when the other does not give us what we want, we forget what he has already given us and we become estranged from him. As far as our critics are concerned: the reaction of the majority is to silence the voice that tells us what we don't like to hear, whether right or not, whether at the opportune moment or whether in the best way possible, as if by being right he has lost his way. Then, let's make an effort to be objective by accepting correction and choosing what our conscience tells us is true; even though, it might be hard for us to acknowledge it.

Resolution: Do not flinch in the face of criticism. Keep silent and later analyze what has been said to you to see if there is any truth in it. Maybe later, you might talk to whomever criticized you.

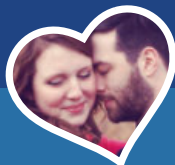
