Word of Life

6th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Avoid the Worst Leprosy

“A leper came to him and kneeling down begged him and said, ‘If you wish, you can make me clean.’ Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, ‘I do will it. Be made clean’.” (Mark 1: 40-41)

The healing of a leper by Jesus places us in the presence of not only a miracle but also a symbol since, at that time, leprosy was considered a disease directly related to sin. To cure a leper was to return him to his community, to give him back to the family of the cleansed, of the saints.

However, this leper does something strange after being cured: he disobeys Jesus and, consciously or not, by spreading word of the miracle, he creates a great problem for the Lord. As the Gospel says, He could no longer “openly enter any town.” He even had to spend nights “in the open.” A favor performed by Christ turns against Him and all because of the disobedience of the recipient of that miracle.

There exists a leprosy even worse than the physical illness. It is a moral leprosy. It is disobedience. It is ingratitude. It is the origin of sin. For this reason, we must allow ourselves God to cure us of this evil. The best way to do this is by living in such a way as to show our appreciation for the many gifts that we have received from Him. How terrible that so many people who are gifted with intelligence or health etc. use them not for good but for evil! They put their gifts at the service of the enemy instead of using them as a means of thanking God for them. God allows this to happen because He respects our freedom, but such a misuse of His gifts will not go unpunished.

Resolution: Examine the temptations that you fall into most often and ask God to help you overcome them. Through your obedience, thank Him for the gifts you have received.



From the Pastor's Desk

My dear parishioners,

It was so gratifying to see that a total of 400 parishioners attended the first Parish Retreat “Hope in the Eucharist” on February 2nd to celebrate 2025 years of Christ’s presence among us in the Eucharist. Only God knows how the consecration to the Blessed Sacrament has been, is and will be transforming our Parish. Proof of it are the testimonies that I have heard about how the daily meditation from the book “33 Days to Eucharistic Glory” have helped our families, and the fact that so many have been so generous in helping raise funds for the new monstrance. It is a manifestation of true faith and love to give the best to the Lord. Let us just look at the Saints and the beautiful churches built in His honor. For those who love Him, they wished they could have more to give even more to Him who loved them first.

The Eucharist is everything, because it is God Himself. He is the greatest treasure of our faith. And consecrating ourselves to Him in the Eucharist is just one more effort to correspond to His infinite love for us. But a consecration without conversion, without letting the Eucharist shape our mindset and lifestyle is fake. It would sound more like a New Age thing, like something vague that does not transform our inner being. Let us not forget that Christianity is incarnation, that is, something concrete, visible. The Son of God became man to transform our human nature, and a spirituality without visible results of more love for God and our neighbor is not authentic Christian Spirituality.

I believe one of the fruits of our Parish Retreat is a new ministry which I have named “CUSTODIANS OF THE EUCHARIST”, and everybody is welcome to join them. Their mission is to accompany the Lord when He is exposed in the Monstrance. They each have committed to adore Him for 30 minutes so that He is not left alone every Thursday from 9AM to 6PM. Julie Kim is the coordinator of this ministry, and her contact information is on page 5 of our bulletin. I have more plans for this group which I will disclose at its proper time.

A Eucharistic community is a community on fire, because the Eucharist is the pledge of divine love that Christ left to His Beloved Bride, the Church, that divine love that He has brought to set the earth on fire, and which He wished to see it ablaze (Lk 12:49)! I wish to see you all aflame in the love for the Eucharist, and you will see that everything else will be added unto us (Mt 6:33).

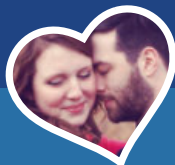
