# Word of Life

## 5th Sunday of Lent: Give Thanks for Forgiveness by Forgiving

"Then the scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery... But when they continued asking him, he straightened up and said to them, 'Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her.'" (Jn 8: 3; 7).

The story of the adulterous woman and the effort that Christ makes in order to save her from the clutches of the vigilantes who were harassing her is a good example of what the Lord does every day for each one of us. He is the mediator before the Father and, if not for His intercession, the just punishment of God would immediately fall upon us. This week's "Word of Life" invites us to consider this merciful aspect of God and also to imitate Him. In order to do so, we must consider that we are comparable to that sinful woman, in need of forgiveness, but sometimes also victims of the defects of other people. Consequently, we are victims and guilty at the same time. As victims, we can forgive and as the guilty, we need forgiveness. So, it is worth remembering that phrase of Jesus in which He told us that we were going to receive the same measure that we used with others. Receive God's absolution by asking for forgiveness and forgiving those who have hurt you.

On the other hand, do not confuse God's mercy toward the sinner for tolerance toward sin. Christ does not say to the adulteress that what she has done is good and that she may continue doing it. He prevents her from being killed and He Himself forgives her, but He invites her never to do it again. The Church has as one of its moral maxims that of condemning the sin but saving the sinner. This is what we must do: condemn what is wrong but try to help the person so that he does not do it again. Just as we would like them to act toward us.

**Resolution:** Reject evil, no matter who commits it, but do not reject the one who does it. Try to help him. Forgive so as to be forgiven. Forgive because we have been forgiven.

# Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

## FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

In this fifth week of Lent, we will follow Jesus from the upper room to the Mount of Olives. After the Passover dinner and after singing a hymn, Jesus with the disciples went to a place called Gethsemane where Jesus said, "Sit here while I go over there to pray. My soul is very sorrowful, even to death; remain here, and watch with Me." Jesus fell on his face and prayed. Yes, like Jesus let's pray, let's fast, and practice more almsgiving to accompany Him in His prayer. At this place Jesus will be betrayed and arrested for our sake, so let's keep watching with prayers, fasting and almsgiving. Let's not leave Him alone. Let's not fall sleep and abandon Him in this troubling hour. The next day after this took place Jesus will be condemned to death, death on the Cross. Jesus, I love you! Jesus I am here with you!





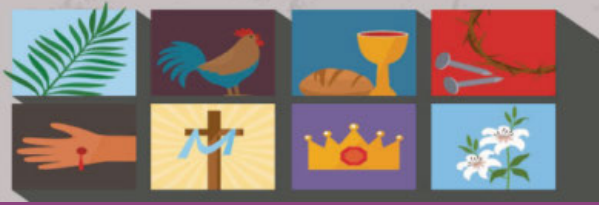
