Word of Life

Palm Sunday: May Your Will Be Done

"After withdrawing about a stone's throw from them and kneeling, he prayed, saying, "Father, if you are willing, take this cup away from me; still, not my will but yours be done."" (Lk 22: 41-42).

Holy Week begins with the full narration of the Passion of the Lord according to Luke the Evangelist. There is a lot to meditate on, a lot to learn. There was an inexhaustible flow of spirituality in those brief days in which Humanity's fate was decided: when the Redeemer gained our salvation by paying for us on the Cross. But of all these things, perhaps there is one that is always close to us: Christ's attitude in the face of the drama to come. Aware as He was of what awaited Him: torture and death, the abandonment of His disciples and even the "kenosis", the feeling of estrangement from God Himself, the Lord was afraid and in anguish. The blood sweat on His forehead was a somatic manifestation of the terror that gripped His spirit. And it is at that moment when He is able to utter the phrase of acceptance of the Divine Will.

The Christ who fled when they wanted to make Him king, let Himself be crowned with thorns. The one who slipped away from the crowd who acclaimed Him, did not turn away when they sought to kill Him. This is the example that He has left us: to accept God's will, whatever it may be, in both good times and bad, in easy times and in difficult. What is even more difficult is to accept that God's will is love, even if it does not seem so to us, even if we do not understand why things happen or why our pleas are not heard so that the cup, which God is asking us to drink, will pass. Of course, in order for us to accept the cross with joy is impossible without God's indispensable strength.

Resolution: Say "yes" to the Lord in whatever He asks of you. Pray and receive the sacraments so that He may give you the strength you need to do His will.

My dear parishioners,

Today we begin Holy Week, the most important week of the Liturgical Year, in which we commemorate the Paschal Mystery of Christ.

One of the risks of routines is that we become so accustomed to them that we take away their novelty, their attractiveness. But it depends. For example, when we celebrate our birthday, we tend to live it in a good mood and to some extent we expect everyone who knows about it to congratulate us and react with joy. There is something always exciting about it, and we never get tired or bored of celebrating it.

If we should celebrate our birthday with joy and gratitude, with even more joy and emotion, we should celebrate the Mysteries of our Redemption every year. Imagine celebrating our birth into this life, knowing that there is nothing after death. Wouldn't it be sad? So much feasting for nothing?! The Paschal Triduum of Christ assures us precisely this: even if we have to suffer a little for Him and the Gospel, we celebrate and rejoice because His victory is ours, because we were created not only to enjoy this life, but to live and reign with Him forever!

I wish you a Paschal Triduum filled with awe and gratitude.




