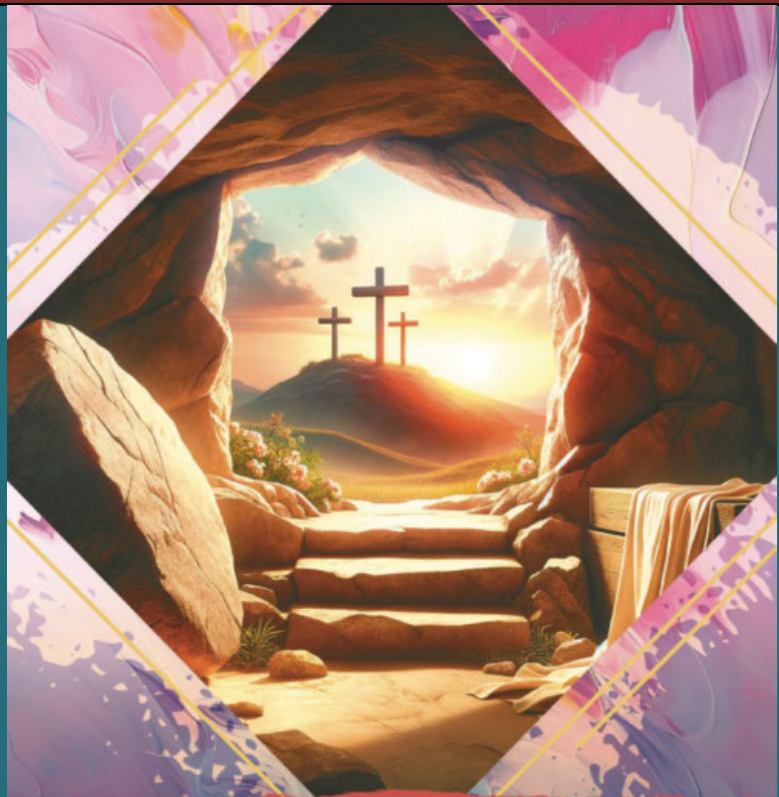

Word of Life

Easter Sunday: Believe in Love

"When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed." (Jn 20: 6-8).

Believe in love, this is the most important thing we must do in life. Believing not only that God exists, but also that He is love. He is always love, even when things do not go as they should for us. But, additionally, believing in love means opting for love as a way of life, as a way of solving social problems and even of defending our legitimate rights. Believing in love implies not believing in war, violence, class conflict, or hatred.

But, how is it possible to believe in God's love and in the constructive power of love after Christ's death on the cross? The defeat on Good Friday was, at least apparently, the defeat of love. Who would dare to follow Christ Crucified knowing that he was necessarily going to end up like Him?

That is why the Resurrection is so decisive. Without it, not only would Christianity not have existed, but the world of ideologies would have lost all utopian, dreamful character, and it would plunge itself into the abyss of the practical, into what is politically possible, and into "an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth," or into "I am going to hit my enemy so hard that he cannot hit me."

One can believe in love -in God's love and in using love as a method of social action- because Christ has risen. God loves you, although on many occasions you do not understand His love and it may even seem to you that He is deaf to your groans and has abandoned you. The lesson is very simple: love may lose thousands of battles, but will end up winning the war.

Resolution: Believe in God's love even in the midst of problems. Reject hatred and violence as the way to solve difficulties. Give thanks to God for having been raised from the dead.

The Lord Jesus has given us the greatest lesson ever! It was not the political way that would save the world, and lead mankind to unity, harmony and peace with one another. 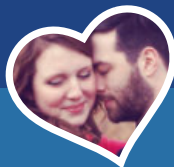
